exclude	Prevent from entering; keep out. The unruly student was exclude d from the game.
extrapolation	The action of estimating or concluding something by assuming that existing trends will continue or a current method will remain applicable. <i>Caution is advised in the interpretation and extrapolation of results.</i>
genius	Someone who is dazzlingly skilled in any field. Boucher s paintings did not suit the austere genius of neoclassicism.



<u>groundbreaking</u>	The ceremonial breaking of the ground to formally begin a construction project. <i>Groundbreaking</i> research into fertility problems.
idea	A mental impression. He has an idea that we don t like him.
<u>imagery</u>	Visually descriptive or figurative language, especially in a literary work. <i>Tennyson uses</i> imagery to create a lyrical emotion.
imaginable	Capable of being imagined. <i>The most spectacular views imaginable.</i>
<u>imaginative</u>	Marked by independence and creativity in thought or action- Lewis Mumford. <i>He was imaginative beyond all other architects.</i>
innovative	(of a product, idea, etc.) featuring new methods; advanced and original. <i>Stylistically innovative works</i> .
<u>inventive</u>	Having the ability to create or design new things or to think originally. <i>Had an inventive turn of mind.</i>
judiciousness	The trait of forming opinions by distinguishing and evaluating.
<u>mentality</u>	Mental ability. <i>Machines can possess mentality.</i>
minded	Interested in or enthusiastic about a particular thing. Career minded .
notion	(usually plural) small personal articles or clothing or sewing items. Children have different notion s about the roles of their parents.
objectively	In a way that is not dependent on the mind for existence; actually. The researchers are objectively assessing risk factors.
philosophical	Characterized by the attitude of a philosopher; meeting trouble with level-headed detachment. <i>Philosophical writing.</i>
<u>reasoning</u>	Endowed with the capacity to reason. <i>He explained the reasoning behind his decision at a media conference.</i>
<u>resourceful</u>	Having inner resources; adroit or imaginative. You will become stronger and more resourceful in the face of adversity.
sagacity	The mental ability to understand and discriminate between relations. <i>A man of great political sagacity.</i>
think	An act of thinking. I think that he is her boyfriend.
