<b>absorbed</b>	Retained without reflection. <i>The <b>absorbed</b> light intensity.</i>
<b>bethink</b>	Consider or ponder something carefully. <i>He bethought himself of the verse from the Book of Proverbs.</i>
<b>brood</b>	Think deeply about something that makes one unhappy, angry, or worried. <i>A <b>brood</b> mare.</i>
<b>careful</b>	Anxious to protect (something) from harm or loss; solicitous. <i><b>Careful</b> of her feelings.</i>
<b>carefully</b>	Taking care or paying attention. <i>He listened <b>carefully</b> to the way people spoke.</i>
<b>cautious</b>	People who are fearful and cautious. <i>Reserved and <b>cautious</b> never making swift decisions.</i>
<b>cogitate</b>	Think deeply about something; meditate or reflect. <i>He stroked his beard and retired to <b>cogitate</b>.</i>
<b>consider</b>	Show consideration for take into account. <i><b>Consider</b> the possibility of moving.</i>
<b>considerate</b>	Showing concern for the rights and feelings of others. <i>Friends <b>considerate</b> enough to leave us alone.</i>
<b>contemplate</b>	Look thoughtfully for a long time at. <i>I <b>contemplated</b> leaving school and taking a full time job.</i>
<b>contemplative</b>	A person devoted to the contemplative life. <i>She regarded me with a <b>contemplative</b> eye.</i>
<b>deliberate</b>	Unhurried and with care and dignity. <i>A conscientious and <b>deliberate</b> worker.</i>
<b>intelligently</b>	In an intelligent manner. <i><b>Intelligently</b> designed products.</i>

<b><u>meditate</u></b>	Think deeply about (something). <i>They had suffered severely and they began to <b>meditate</b> retreat.</i>
<b>meditative</b>	Deeply or seriously thoughtful. <i><b>Meditative</b> techniques.</i>
<b>mirror</b>	Reflect as if in a mirror. <i>His site was <b>mirrored</b> at several colleges around the United States.</i>
<b>mirrored</b>	Like or characteristic of a mirror image. <i><b>Mirrored</b> sunglasses.</i>
<b>mull</b>	Think about (a fact, proposal, or request) deeply and at length. <i>I <b>mulled</b> over the events of the afternoon.</i>
<b><u>muse</u></b>	In ancient Greek mythology any of 9 daughters of Zeus and Mnemosyne; protector of an art or science. <i>Yeats <b>muse</b> Maud Gonne.</i>
<b>pensive</b>	Showing pensive sadness. <i>A <b>pensive</b> mood.</i>
<b><u>ponder</u></b>	Reflect deeply on a subject. <i>She sat <b>pondering</b> over her problem.</i>
<b><u>preoccupied</u></b>	Deeply absorbed in thought. <i>A <b>preoccupied</b> frown.</i>
<b><u>reconsider</u></b>	Consider again (a bill) that had been voted upon before, with a view to altering it. <i>They called on the US government to <b>reconsider</b> its policy.</i>
<b><u>reflect</u></b>	Reflect deeply on a subject. <i>Sound is <b>reflected</b> well in this auditorium.</i>
<b><u>reflective</u></b>	Produced by reflection. <i>The <b>reflective</b> type.</i>
<b><u>ruminare</u></b>	Chew the cud. <i>Cows <b>ruminare</b>.</i>
<b>slowly</b>	Without speed slow is sometimes used informally for slowly. <i>They moved forward <b>slowly</b>.</i>
<b><u>speculate</u></b>	Invest in stocks, property, or other ventures in the hope of gain but with the risk of loss. <i>Observers <b>speculated</b> that the authorities wished to improve their image.</i>
<b>subjectively</b>	In a subjective way. <i>Samples of the product were <b>subjectively</b> evaluated.</i>
<b>thoughtful</b>	Taking heed giving close and thoughtful attention. <i>A <b>thoughtful</b> paper.</i>
