absorbed	Retained without reflection. <i>The absorbed light intensity.</i>
bethink	Consider or ponder something carefully. <i>He bethought himself of the verse from the Book of Proverbs.</i>
brood	Think deeply about something that makes one unhappy, angry, or worried. <i>A brood mare.</i>
careful	Anxious to protect (something) from harm or loss; solicitous. <i>Careful of her feelings.</i>
carefully	Taking care or paying attention. <i>He listened carefully to the way people spoke.</i>
cautious	People who are fearful and cautious. <i>Reserved and cautious never making swift decisions.</i>
cogitate	Think deeply about something; meditate or reflect. <i>He stroked his beard and retired to cogitate.</i>
consider	Show consideration for take into account. <i>Consider the possibility of moving.</i>
considerate	Showing concern for the rights and feelings of others. <i>Friends considerate enough to leave us alone.</i>
contemplate	Look thoughtfully for a long time at. <i>I contemplated leaving school and taking a full time job.</i>
contemplative	A person devoted to the contemplative life. <i>She regarded me with a contemplative eye.</i>
deliberate	Unhurried and with care and dignity. <i>A conscientious and deliberate worker.</i>
intelligently	In an intelligent manner. <i>Intelligently designed products.</i>

<u>meditate</u>	Think deeply about (something). <i>They had suffered severely and they began to meditate retreat.</i>
meditative	Deeply or seriously thoughtful. <i>Meditative techniques.</i>
mirror	Reflect as if in a mirror. <i>His site was mirrored at several colleges around the United States.</i>
mirrored	Like or characteristic of a mirror image. <i>Mirrored sunglasses.</i>
mull	Think about (a fact, proposal, or request) deeply and at length. <i>I mulled over the events of the afternoon.</i>
<u>muse</u>	In ancient Greek mythology any of 9 daughters of Zeus and Mnemosyne; protector of an art or science. <i>Yeats muse Maud Gonne.</i>
pensive	Showing pensive sadness. <i>A pensive mood.</i>
<u>ponder</u>	Reflect deeply on a subject. <i>She sat pondering over her problem.</i>
<u>preoccupied</u>	Deeply absorbed in thought. <i>A preoccupied frown.</i>
<u>reconsider</u>	Consider again (a bill) that had been voted upon before, with a view to altering it. <i>They called on the US government to reconsider its policy.</i>
<u>reflect</u>	Reflect deeply on a subject. <i>Sound is reflected well in this auditorium.</i>
<u>reflective</u>	Produced by reflection. <i>The reflective type.</i>
<u>ruminare</u>	Chew the cuds. <i>Cows ruminare.</i>
slowly	Without speed slow is sometimes used informally for slowly. <i>They moved forward slowly.</i>
<u>speculate</u>	Invest in stocks, property, or other ventures in the hope of gain but with the risk of loss. <i>Observers speculated that the authorities wished to improve their image.</i>
subjectively	In a subjective way. <i>Samples of the product were subjectively evaluated.</i>
thoughtful	Taking heed giving close and thoughtful attention. <i>A thoughtful paper.</i>
