### Definitions of "Thoughtless" as an adjective

According to the <u>Oxford Dictionary of English</u>, "thoughtless" as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- Showing lack of careful thought.
- (of a person or their behaviour) not showing consideration for the needs of other people.
- Without consideration of the possible consequences.
- Without care or thought for others.





### Synonyms of "Thoughtless" as an adjective (24 Words)

careless Effortless and unstudied.

He was **careless** of his own safety.

foolish Devoid of good sense or judgment.

A **foolish** decision.

heedless Marked by or paying little heed or attention-Franklin D. Roosevelt.

**Heedless** of danger.

**ill-advised** Without careful prior deliberation or counsel.

ill-considered Not given careful consideration.

imprudent Lacking wise self-restraint.

It would be **imprudent** to leave her winter coat behind.

Thoughtlessly causing hurt or inconvenience to others.

inconsiderate Shockingly inconsiderate behavior.



injudicious Showing very poor judgement; unwise.

I took a few **injudicious** swigs of potent cider.

insensitive Not responsive to physical stimuli.

Both were in many ways **insensitive** to painting.

neglectful Not giving proper care or attention to someone or something.

**Neglectful** parents.

**negligent** Failing to take proper care over something.

**Negligent** of detail.

**precipitate**Done with very great haste and without due deliberation.

A **precipitate** decline in Labour fortunes.

rash Marked by defiant disregard for danger or consequences-Macaulay.

A **rash** attempt to climb Mount Everest.

reckless Marked by defiant disregard for danger or consequences-Macaulay.

You mustn t be so **reckless**.

regardless Without due thought or consideration.

Crushing the blooms with **regardless** tread.

remiss Failing in what duty requires.

It would be very **remiss** of me not to pass on that information.

Denoting fielding positions very close to the batsman.

silly

Don t be **silly** she said.

without care or thought for others.

An **uncaring** person.

uncharitable Lacking love and generosity- Charles Reade.

This **uncharitable** remark possibly arose out of jealousy.

**unkind** Inconsiderate and harsh to others.

The **unkind**est cut of all.

unmindful Lacking conscious awareness of.

While thus **unmindful** of his steps he stumbled.

**unthinking** Without care or thought for others.

She was at pains to correct **unthinking** prejudices.

Not appropriate to the purpose.

*unwise*It is *unwise* to rely on hearsay evidence.





## Usage Examples of "Thoughtless" as an adjective

- The debate turned into thoughtless bickering.
- It was thoughtless of her to have rushed out and not said where she would be going.
- To think a few minutes of thoughtless pleasure could end in this.
- The thoughtless saying of a great princess on being informed that the people had no bread; `Let them eat cake.
