Definitions of "Thoughtless" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “thoughtless” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Showing lack of careful thought.*
- *(of a person or their behaviour) not showing consideration for the needs of other people.*
- *Without consideration of the possible consequences.*
- *Without care or thought for others.*



Synonyms of "Thoughtless" as an adjective (24 Words)

<u>careless</u>	Effortless and unstudied. <i>He was careless of his own safety.</i>
foolish	Devoid of good sense or judgment. <i>A foolish decision.</i>
heedless	Marked by or paying little heed or attention-Franklin D. Roosevelt. <i>Heedless of danger.</i>
ill-advised	Without careful prior deliberation or counsel.
ill-considered	Not given careful consideration.
imprudent	Lacking wise self-restraint. <i>It would be imprudent to leave her winter coat behind.</i>
<u>inconsiderate</u>	Thoughtlessly causing hurt or inconvenience to others. <i>Shockingly inconsiderate behavior.</i>

injudicious	Showing very poor judgement; unwise. <i>I took a few injudicious swigs of potent cider.</i>
<u>insensitive</u>	Not responsive to physical stimuli. <i>Both were in many ways insensitive to painting.</i>
neglectful	Not giving proper care or attention to someone or something. <i>Neglectful parents.</i>
negligent	Failing to take proper care over something. <i>Negligent of detail.</i>
<u>precipitate</u>	Done with very great haste and without due deliberation. <i>A precipitate decline in Labour fortunes.</i>
rash	Marked by defiant disregard for danger or consequences-Macaulay. <i>A rash attempt to climb Mount Everest.</i>
<u>reckless</u>	Marked by defiant disregard for danger or consequences-Macaulay. <i>You mustn't be so reckless.</i>
<u>regardless</u>	Without due thought or consideration. <i>Crushing the blooms with regardless tread.</i>
<u>remiss</u>	Failing in what duty requires. <i>It would be very remiss of me not to pass on that information.</i>
silly	Denoting fielding positions very close to the batsman. <i>Don't be silly she said.</i>
<u>uncaring</u>	Without care or thought for others. <i>An uncaring person.</i>
uncharitable	Lacking love and generosity- Charles Reade. <i>This uncharitable remark possibly arose out of jealousy.</i>
<u>unkind</u>	Inconsiderate and harsh to others. <i>The unkindest cut of all.</i>
unmindful	Lacking conscious awareness of. <i>While thus unmindful of his steps he stumbled.</i>
unthinking	Without care or thought for others. <i>She was at pains to correct unthinking prejudices.</i>
<u>unwise</u>	Not appropriate to the purpose. <i>It is unwise to rely on hearsay evidence.</i>



Usage Examples of "Thoughtless" as an adjective

- *The debate turned into thoughtless bickering.*
- *It was thoughtless of her to have rushed out and not said where she would be going.*
- *To think a few minutes of thoughtless pleasure could end in this.*
- *The thoughtless saying of a great princess on being informed that the people had no bread; 'Let them eat cake.'*
