## Thoughtless as an Adjective

### Definitions of "Thoughtless" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “thoughtless” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Showing lack of careful thought.*
- *(of a person or their behaviour) not showing consideration for the needs of other people.*
- *Without consideration of the possible consequences.*
- *Without care or thought for others.*



## Synonyms of "Thoughtless" as an adjective (24 Words)

- careless** Effortless and unstudied.  
*He was **careless** of his own safety.*
- foolish** Devoid of good sense or judgment.  
*A **foolish** decision.*
- heedless** Marked by or paying little heed or attention-Franklin D. Roosevelt.  
***Heedless** of danger.*
- ill-advised** Without careful prior deliberation or counsel.
- ill-considered** Not given careful consideration.
- imprudent** Lacking wise self-restraint.  
*It would be **imprudent** to leave her winter coat behind.*
- inconsiderate** Thoughtlessly causing hurt or inconvenience to others.  
*Shockingly **inconsiderate** behavior.*

<b>injudicious</b>	Showing very poor judgement; unwise. <i>I took a few <b>injudicious</b> swigs of potent cider.</i>
<b><u>insensitive</u></b>	Not responsive to physical stimuli. <i>Both were in many ways <b>insensitive</b> to painting.</i>
<b>neglectful</b>	Not giving proper care or attention to someone or something. <i><b>Neglectful</b> parents.</i>
<b>negligent</b>	Failing to take proper care over something. <i><b>Negligent</b> of detail.</i>
<b><u>precipitate</u></b>	Done with very great haste and without due deliberation. <i>A <b>precipitate</b> decline in Labour fortunes.</i>
<b>rash</b>	Marked by defiant disregard for danger or consequences-Macaulay. <i>A <b>rash</b> attempt to climb Mount Everest.</i>
<b><u>reckless</u></b>	Marked by defiant disregard for danger or consequences-Macaulay. <i>You mustn't be so <b>reckless</b>.</i>
<b><u>regardless</u></b>	Without due thought or consideration. <i>Crushing the blooms with <b>regardless</b> tread.</i>
<b><u>remiss</u></b>	Failing in what duty requires. <i>It would be very <b>remiss</b> of me not to pass on that information.</i>
<b>silly</b>	Denoting fielding positions very close to the batsman. <i>Don't be <b>silly</b> she said.</i>
<b><u>uncaring</u></b>	Without care or thought for others. <i>An <b>uncaring</b> person.</i>
<b>uncharitable</b>	Lacking love and generosity- Charles Reade. <i>This <b>uncharitable</b> remark possibly arose out of jealousy.</i>
<b><u>unkind</u></b>	Inconsiderate and harsh to others. <i>The <b>unkindest</b> cut of all.</i>
<b>unmindful</b>	Lacking conscious awareness of. <i>While thus <b>unmindful</b> of his steps he stumbled.</i>
<b>unthinking</b>	Without care or thought for others. <i>She was at pains to correct <b>unthinking</b> prejudices.</i>
<b><u>unwise</u></b>	Not appropriate to the purpose. <i>It is <b>unwise</b> to rely on hearsay evidence.</i>





## Usage Examples of "Thoughtless" as an adjective

- *The debate turned into thoughtless bickering.*
- *It was thoughtless of her to have rushed out and not said where she would be going.*
- *To think a few minutes of thoughtless pleasure could end in this.*
- *The thoughtless saying of a great princess on being informed that the people had no bread; `Let them eat cake.*
