Past Tense	throated
Present Participle	throating
Past Participle	throated

Conjugate Throat

Throat in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **throat** We **throat**
You **throat** You **throat**
He/She/It **throats** They **throat**

Throat in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I **am throating** We **are throating**
You **are throating** You **are throating**
He/She/It **is throating** They **are throating**

Throat in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I **have throated** We **have throated**
You **have throated** You **have throated**
He/She/It **has throated** They **have throated**

Throat in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I **have been throating** We **have been throating**
You **have been throating** You **have been throating**
He/She/It **has been throating** They **have been throating**

Throat in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **throated** We **throated**
You **throated** You **throated**
He/She/It **throated** They **throated**

Throat in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was throating	We were throating
You were throating	You were throating
He/She/It was throating	They were throating

Throat in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had throated	We had throated
You had throated	You had throated
He/She/It had throated	They had throated

Throat in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been throating	We had been throating
You had been throating	You had been throating
He/She/It had been throating	They had been throating

Throat in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will throat	We will throat
You will throat	You will throat
He/She/It will throat	They will throat

Throat in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be throating	We will be throating
You will be throating	You will be throating
He/She/It will be throating	They will be throating

Throat in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have throated

We will have throated

You will have throated

You will have throated

He/She/It will have throated

They will have throated

Throat in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have been throating

We will have been throating

You will have been throating

You will have been throating

He/She/It will have been throating

They will have been throating
