balance	A weight that balances another weight. <i>A surplus on the capital account to make the account balance.</i>

class	Arrange or order by classes or categories. <i>People who are socially disenfranchised by class.</i>
course	Part of a meal served at one time. <i>The government took a firm course.</i>
echelon	Arrange in an echelon formation. <i>The Task Force would take the left echeloned to be able to sweep in from the west.</i>
epidermis	The outer layer of the skin covering the exterior body surface of vertebrates.
even	Being level or straight or regular and without variation as e g in shape or texture or being in the same plane or at the same height as something else i e even with. <i>What is this whole thing even about.</i>
extent	The point or degree to which something extends. <i>An enclosure ten acres in extent.</i>
grade	Arrange in or allocate to grades classify or sort. <i>A moderate grade of intelligence.</i>
grading	Changing the ground level to a smooth horizontal or gently sloping surface. <i>What he disliked about teaching was all the grading he had to do.</i>
impermeable	Preventing especially liquids to pass or diffuse through. <i>Impermeable stone.</i>
juridical	Relating to judicial proceedings and the administration of the law. <i>Juridical days.</i>

level	Become level or even. <i>Level criticism or charges at somebody.</i>
middlebrow	A middlebrow person. <i>Middlebrow fiction.</i>
midway	Having some of the characteristics of one thing and some of another. <i>He sensationally led the tournament at the midway point.</i>
notch	Secure or insert by means of notches. <i>Notch the rope.</i>
octane	Any isomeric saturated hydrocarbon found in petroleum and used as a fuel and solvent.
pentavalent	Having a valence of five.
phase	Each of the electrical windings or connections of a polyphase machine or circuit. <i>About 70 of the reflections were phased by this method.</i>
qualification	The qualification stage of a sporting event. <i>The five year residency qualification for presidential candidates.</i>
range	Obtain the range of a target by adjustment after firing past it or short of it or by the use of radar or laser equipment. <i>Range the animals in the prairie.</i>
rank	Take precedence or surpass others in rank. <i>An army officer of high rank.</i>
scale	Remove the scales from. <i>The skin may scale and peel away with itching stinging or burning sensations in the infected area.</i>
spectrum	The components of a sound or other phenomenon arranged according to such characteristics as frequency, charge, and energy. <i>Self help books are covering a broader and broader spectrum.</i>
status	A posting on a social networking website that indicates a user's current situation, state of mind, or opinion about something. <i>When I updated my status on Facebook yesterday I said I was seeking a sense of purpose.</i>
step	The sound of a step of someone walking. <i>The steps are in the outhouse.</i>
straddle	The option to buy or sell a given stock (or stock index or commodity future) at a given price before a given date; consists of an equal number of put and call options. <i>A sideways on stance such as a straddle.</i>

(of seeds) placed close together in layers in moist sand or peat to preserve them or to help them germinate.
