# **Conjugate Till**

### **Till in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>till</b>	We <b>till</b>
You <b>till</b>	You <b>till</b>
He/She/It <b>tills</b>	They <b>till</b>

## **Till in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>am tilling</b>	We <b>are tilling</b>
You <b>are tilling</b>	You <b>are tilling</b>
He/She/It is tilling	They are tilling

#### **Till in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have tilled	We have tilled
You have tilled	You have tilled
He/She/It has tilled	They have tilled

#### **Till in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been tilling	We have been tilling
You have been tilling	You have been tilling
He/She/It has been tilling	They have been tilling

## **Till in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>tilled</b>	We <b>tilled</b>
You <b>tilled</b>	You <b>tilled</b>
He/She/It <b>tilled</b>	They <b>tilled</b>

### **Till in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was tilling	We <b>were tilling</b>
You <b>were tilling</b>	You were tilling
He/She/It was tilling	They were tilling

#### **Till in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had tilled	We <b>had tilled</b>
You <b>had tilled</b>	You <b>had tilled</b>
He/She/It had tilled	They had tilled

### **Till in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been tilling	We <b>had been tilling</b>
You <b>had been tilling</b>	You had been tilling
He/She/It had been tilling	They had been tilling

## **Till in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will till	We will till
You <b>will till</b>	You <b>will till</b>
He/She/It will till	They will till

## **Till in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be tilling	We <b>will be tilling</b>
You <b>will be tilling</b>	You <b>will be tilling</b>
He/She/It will be tilling	They will be tilling

#### **Till in Future Perfect Tense**

#### **Till in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**
