almanac	An annual publication containing tabular information in a particular field or fields arranged according to the calendar of a given year.
annually	Without missing a year. They travel to China <b>annually</b> .
april	The month following March and preceding May.
<u>biannual</u>	Occurring twice a year. The <b>biannual</b> meeting of the planning committee.
<u>calendar</u>	Enter something in a calendar or timetable. I have you on my <b>calendar</b> for next Monday.
centenary	The 100th anniversary (or the celebration of it. The <b>centenary</b> year of the artist s birth.
<u>concomitant</u>	An event or situation that happens at the same time as or in connection with another. He sought promotion without the necessary <b>concomitant</b> of hard work.
<u>daily</u>	Every day. The museum is open <b>daily</b> .
day	The part of a day when it is light the time between sunrise and sunset. We ll leave the <b>day</b> after tomorrow.
<u>ensuing</u>	Occurring afterwards or as a result. She lost track of one of her children during the <b>ensuing</b> chaos.
hour	The distance travelled in one hour. Rates of pay were low starting at 3 20 an <b>hour</b> .
<u>late</u>	Later than usual or than expected. <i>Late</i> r medical science could have saved the child.



monthly	A magazine that is published once a month. An Anglo American <b>monthly</b> whose appeal was always international.
o'clock	According to the clock.
oft	Many times at short intervals. An <b>oft</b> quoted tenet.
period	A set of elements occupying a horizontal row in the periodic table. <i>He interviewed the teachers when they had a free</i> <b>period</b> .
<u>periodic</u>	Relating to the periodic table of the elements. The <b>periodic</b> visits she made to her father.
periodically	From time to time; occasionally. The students received help from a friend only <b>periodically</b> .
periodicity	The quality or character of being periodic; the tendency to recur at intervals. <i>The periodicity</i> of the sunspot cycle.
recent	The Holocene epoch. A <b>recent</b> addition to the house.
regular	A soldier in the regular army. <b>Regular</b> bus departures.
<u>regularly</u>	With a constant or definite pattern, especially with the same space between individual items. A <b>regularly</b> updated news page.
semiannual	Occurring or payable twice each year.
<u>shortly</u>	Abruptly, sharply, or curtly. <i>To put it <b>shortly</b>.</i>
<u>thereafter</u>	After that time. It was agreed that the meeting be held annually <b>thereafter</b> .
timing	The choice, judgement, or control of when something should be done. One of the secrets of cricket is good <b>timing</b> .
<u>tomorrow</u>	The day after today. <b>Tomorrow</b> s Grand Prix in Brazil.
<u>weekly</u>	A newspaper or periodical issued every week. There was a <b>weekly</b> dance on Wednesdays.
<u>year</u>	A year regarded in terms of the quality of something produced. She was in my <b>year</b> at Hoehandle High.
