afternoon	In the afternoon every afternoon. <i>I ll be back at three in the afternoon.</i>
almanac	An annual publication containing tabular information in a particular field or fields arranged according to the calendar of a given year.
annually	Without missing a year. <i>They travel to China annually.</i>
april	The month following March and preceding May.
biannual	Occurring twice a year. <i>The biannual meeting of the planning committee.</i>
calendar	Enter something in a calendar or timetable. <i>I have you on my calendar for next Monday.</i>
centenary	The 100th anniversary (or the celebration of it). <i>The centenary year of the artist s birth.</i>
concomitant	An event or situation that happens at the same time as or in connection with another. <i>He sought promotion without the necessary concomitant of hard work.</i>
daily	Every day. <i>The museum is open daily.</i>
day	The part of a day when it is light the time between sunrise and sunset. <i>We ll leave the day after tomorrow.</i>
ensuing	Occurring afterwards or as a result. <i>She lost track of one of her children during the ensuing chaos.</i>
hour	The distance travelled in one hour. <i>Rates of pay were low starting at 3 20 an hour.</i>
late	Later than usual or than expected. <i>Later medical science could have saved the child.</i>

monthly	A magazine that is published once a month. <i>An Anglo American monthly whose appeal was always international.</i>
o'clock	According to the clock.
oft	Many times at short intervals. <i>An oft quoted tenet.</i>
period	A set of elements occupying a horizontal row in the periodic table. <i>He interviewed the teachers when they had a free period.</i>
<u>periodic</u>	Relating to the periodic table of the elements. <i>The periodic visits she made to her father.</i>
periodically	From time to time; occasionally. <i>The students received help from a friend only periodically.</i>
periodicity	The quality or character of being periodic; the tendency to recur at intervals. <i>The periodicity of the sunspot cycle.</i>
recent	The Holocene epoch. <i>A recent addition to the house.</i>
regular	A soldier in the regular army. <i>Regular bus departures.</i>
<u>regularly</u>	With a constant or definite pattern, especially with the same space between individual items. <i>A regularly updated news page.</i>
semiannual	Occurring or payable twice each year.
<u>shortly</u>	Abruptly, sharply, or curtly. <i>To put it shortly.</i>
<u>thereafter</u>	After that time. <i>It was agreed that the meeting be held annually thereafter.</i>
timing	The choice, judgement, or control of when something should be done. <i>One of the secrets of cricket is good timing.</i>
<u>tomorrow</u>	The day after today. <i>Tomorrow s Grand Prix in Brazil.</i>
<u>weekly</u>	A newspaper or periodical issued every week. <i>There was a weekly dance on Wednesdays.</i>
<u>year</u>	A year regarded in terms of the quality of something produced. <i>She was in my year at Hoehandle High.</i>
