tingle A slight prickling or stinging sensation.

- *Exciting by touching lightly so as to cause laughter or twitching movements.*

tickling Exciting by touching lightly so as to cause laughter or twitching movements.

titillating Arousing mild sexual excitement or interest; salacious.
*She let slip **titillating** details about her clients.*
