<b>arduous</b>	Difficult to accomplish; demanding considerable mental effort and skill. <i>The <b>arduous</b> work of preparing a dictionary.</i>
<b>assiduity</b>	Great and constant diligence and attention. <i>The <b>assiduity</b> with which he could wear down his opponents.</i>
<b>cheerily</b>	In a happy and optimistic way. <i>The children were waving <b>cheerily</b>.</i>
<b>diligence</b>	Careful and persistent work or effort. <i>Few party members challenge his <b>diligence</b> as an MP.</i>
<b>diligent</b>	Having or showing care and conscientiousness in one's work or duties. <i>A <b>diligent</b> detective investigates all clues.</i>
<b>eager</b>	A high wave (often dangerous) caused by tidal flow (as by colliding tidal currents or in a narrow estuary). <i>Young intellectuals <b>eager</b> for knowledge.</i>
<b>effort</b>	Use of physical or mental energy; hard work. <i>Contributed to the war <b>effort</b>.</i>
<b>endeavor</b>	A purposeful or industrious undertaking (especially one that requires effort or boldness). <i>Wished him luck in his <b>endeavor</b>.</i>
<b>energetic</b>	Showing or involving great activity or vitality. <i><b>Energetic</b> X rays.</i>
<b>enterprising</b>	Marked by imagination, initiative, and readiness to undertake new projects. <i>Some <b>enterprising</b> teachers have started their own recycling programmes.</i>
<b>enthusiasm</b>	Something that arouses enthusiasm. <i>Few expressed <b>enthusiasm</b> about the current leaders.</i>
<b>exertion</b>	The application of a force, influence, or quality. <i>A well earned rest after their <b>exertions</b>.</i>
<b>fervent</b>	Hot, burning, or glowing. <i>A <b>fervent</b> supporter of the revolution.</i>
<b>hard</b>	Causing great damage or hardship. <i>It was raining <b>hard</b>.</i>
<b>indefatigable</b>	Showing sustained enthusiastic action with unflagging vitality. <i>An <b>indefatigable</b> defender of human rights.</i>
<b>industrious</b>	Working hard to promote an enterprise. <i>An <b>industrious</b> people striving to make their country prosperous.</i>
<b>inexhaustible</b>	Incapable of being entirely consumed or used up. <i>His <b>inexhaustible</b> energy.</i>
<b>pains</b>	An effortful attempt to attain a goal.

<b><u>painstaking</u></b>	Characterized by extreme care and great effort. <i>He is a gentle <b>painstaking</b> man.</i>
<b><u>steady</u></b>	Make or become steady. <b>Steady</b> nerves.
<b>strenuous</b>	Taxing to the utmost; testing powers of endurance- F.D.Roosevelt. <b>Strenuous</b> exercise.
<b>striving</b>	An effortful attempt to attain a goal.
<b>submerge</b>	Put under water. <i>Pellets were then <b>submersed</b> in agar.</i>
<b>torrid</b>	Very hot and dry. <i>Hot trumpets and <b>torrid</b> rhythms.</i>
<b>try</b>	An act of trying something new or different to see if it is suitable effective or pleasant. <i>You are <b>trying</b> my patience.</i>
<b>unflagging</b>	Showing sustained enthusiastic action with unflagging vitality. <b>Unflagging</b> pursuit of excellence.
<b><u>vigorous</u></b>	Strong and active physically or mentally. <i>A tall <b>vigorous</b> and muscular man.</i>
<b>zealotry</b>	Excessive intolerance of opposing views. <i>He expressed concern about religious <b>zealotry</b> playing an increasing role in politics.</i>
