come	Come from be connected by a relationship of blood for example. <i>Your wish will come true.</i>
derive	Obtain. <i>Derive pleasure from one s garden.</i>
<u>earn</u>	Earn on some commercial or business transaction earn as salary or wages. <i>This latest win earned them 50 000 in prize money.</i>
expulsion	The act of expelling or projecting or ejecting. <i>His expulsion from the union.</i>

fetch	The action of fetching. <i>He ran to fetch help.</i>
gain	The amount of increase in signal power or voltage or current expressed as the ratio of output to input. <i>We gained the ridge.</i>
have	Have a personal or business relationship with someone. <i>How much time have I got for the presentation.</i>
<u>incur</u>	Become subject to (something unwelcome or unpleasant) as a result of one's own behaviour or actions. <i>People who smoke incur a great danger to their health.</i>
obtain	Be prevalent, customary, or established. <i>How did you obtain the visa.</i>
obtainable	Capable of being obtained. <i>Customers financial details are easily obtainable.</i>
possession	The state of being controlled by a demon or spirit. <i>France s former colonial possessions.</i>
procure	Arrange for sexual partners for others. <i>He persuaded a friend to procure him a ticket.</i>
<u>procurement</u>	The action of obtaining or procuring something. <i>The company s procurements from foreign firms.</i>
purchase	Something acquired by purchase. <i>He could get no purchase on the situation.</i>
reach	The act of physically reaching or thrusting out. <i>Government reaches out to the people.</i>
receive	Receive as a retribution or punishment. <i>Representatives of the club will be received by the Mayor.</i>
recipient	A person or thing that receives or is awarded something. <i>The recipient of the Nobel Peace Prize.</i>
<u>regain</u>	Get or find back; recover the use of. <i>She regained control of herself.</i>
retrieval	The action of obtaining or consulting material stored in a computer system. <i>Storage and retrieval systems.</i>
<u>secure</u>	Free from danger or risk. <i>A secure investment.</i>
wangle	An act or an instance of obtaining something by persuasion or clever manipulation. <i>A rather clever wangle on the part of some of the folk at the office.</i>
