<a href="#">attainable</a>	Able to be attained; achievable. <i>Yields in excess of 6 are easily <b>attainable</b>.</i>
<b>available</b>	Convenient for use or disposal. <i>Kept a fire extinguisher <b>available</b>.</i>
<b>bring</b>	Go or come after and bring or take back. <i>Can I <b>bring</b> my cousin to the dinner.</i>
<b>come</b>	Come from be connected by a relationship of blood for example. <i>Your wish will <b>come</b> true.</i>
<b>derive</b>	Obtain. <i><b>Derive</b> pleasure from one s garden.</i>
<a href="#">earn</a>	Earn on some commercial or business transaction earn as salary or wages. <i>This latest win <b>earned</b> them 50 000 in prize money.</i>
<b>expulsion</b>	The act of expelling or projecting or ejecting. <i>His <b>expulsion</b> from the union.</i>

<b>fetch</b>	The action of fetching. <i>He ran to <b>fetch</b> help.</i>
<b>gain</b>	The amount of increase in signal power or voltage or current expressed as the ratio of output to input. <i>We <b>gained</b> the ridge.</i>
<b>have</b>	Have a personal or business relationship with someone. <i>How much time <b>have</b> I got for the presentation.</i>
<b><u>incur</u></b>	Become subject to (something unwelcome or unpleasant) as a result of one's own behaviour or actions. <i>People who smoke <b>incur</b> a great danger to their health.</i>
<b>obtain</b>	Be prevalent, customary, or established. <i>How did you <b>obtain</b> the visa.</i>
<b>obtainable</b>	Capable of being obtained. <i>Customers financial details are easily <b>obtainable</b>.</i>
<b>possession</b>	The state of being controlled by a demon or spirit. <i>France s former colonial <b>possessions</b>.</i>
<b>procure</b>	Arrange for sexual partners for others. <i>He persuaded a friend to <b>procure</b> him a ticket.</i>
<b><u>procurement</u></b>	The action of obtaining or procuring something. <i>The company s <b>procurements</b> from foreign firms.</i>
<b>purchase</b>	Something acquired by purchase. <i>He could get no <b>purchase</b> on the situation.</i>
<b>reach</b>	The act of physically reaching or thrusting out. <i>Government <b>reaches</b> out to the people.</i>
<b>receive</b>	Receive as a retribution or punishment. <i>Representatives of the club will be <b>received</b> by the Mayor.</i>
<b>recipient</b>	A person or thing that receives or is awarded something. <i>The <b>recipient</b> of the Nobel Peace Prize.</i>
<b><u>regain</u></b>	Get or find back; recover the use of. <i>She <b>regained</b> control of herself.</i>
<b>retrieval</b>	The action of obtaining or consulting material stored in a computer system. <i>Storage and <b>retrieval</b> systems.</i>
<b><u>secure</u></b>	Free from danger or risk. <i>A <b>secure</b> investment.</i>
<b>wangle</b>	An act or an instance of obtaining something by persuasion or clever manipulation. <i>A rather clever <b>wangle</b> on the part of some of the folk at the office.</i>
