Infinitive	<b>to toat</b>
Present Tense	<b>toat / toats</b>
Past Tense	<b>toated</b>
Present Participle	<b>toating</b>
Past Participle	<b>toated</b>

## Conjugate Toat

**Toat in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>toat</b>	We <b>toat</b>
You <b>toat</b>	You <b>toat</b>
He/She/It <b>toats</b>	They <b>toat</b>

### **Toat in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>am toating</b>	We <b>are toating</b>
You <b>are toating</b>	You <b>are toating</b>
He/She/It <b>is toating</b>	They <b>are toating</b>

### **Toat in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>have toated</b>	We <b>have toated</b>
You <b>have toated</b>	You <b>have toated</b>
He/She/It <b>has toated</b>	They <b>have toated</b>

### **Toat in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>have been toating</b>	We <b>have been toating</b>
You <b>have been toating</b>	You <b>have been toating</b>
He/She/It <b>has been toating</b>	They <b>have been toating</b>

### **Toat in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>toated</b>	We <b>toated</b>
You <b>toated</b>	You <b>toated</b>
He/She/It <b>toated</b>	They <b>toated</b>

### **Toat in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I was toating</b>	<b>We were toating</b>
<b>You were toating</b>	<b>You were toating</b>
<b>He/She/It was toating</b>	<b>They were toating</b>

**Toat in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I had toated</b>	<b>We had toated</b>
<b>You had toated</b>	<b>You had toated</b>
<b>He/She/It had toated</b>	<b>They had toated</b>

**Toat in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I had been toating</b>	<b>We had been toating</b>
<b>You had been toating</b>	<b>You had been toating</b>
<b>He/She/It had been toating</b>	<b>They had been toating</b>

**Toat in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I will toat</b>	<b>We will toat</b>
<b>You will toat</b>	<b>You will toat</b>
<b>He/She/It will toat</b>	<b>They will toat</b>

**Toat in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Plural**

<b>I will be toating</b>	<b>We will be toating</b>
<b>You will be toating</b>	<b>You will be toating</b>
<b>He/She/It will be toating</b>	<b>They will be toating</b>

**Toat in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have toated**

**We will have toated**

**You will have toated**

**You will have toated**

**He/She/It will have toated**

**They will have toated**

**Toat in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been toating**

**We will have been toating**

**You will have been toating**

**You will have been toating**

**He/She/It will have been toating**

**They will have been toating**
