crest	The top line of a hill, mountain, or wave. <i>The swell begins to curl and crest</i> .
elevated	Of high moral or intellectual value elevated in nature or style. This hotel has an elevated position above the village.
<u>elevation</u>	The ability of a dancer to attain height in jumps. As every gunner knows increasing the elevation beyond five degrees can be a risky business.
ladder	With reference to tights or stockings develop or cause to develop a ladder. <i>He climbed the career ladder.</i>
lid	An eyelid. <i>A dustbin lid.</i>
<u>lofty</u>	Having or displaying great dignity or nobility. An extraordinary mixture of harsh reality and lofty ideals.



<u>maximum</u>	A maximum permitted custodial sentence for an offence. <i>The school takes a maximum of 32 pupils.</i>
meridian	Relating to or situated at a meridian. The European Broadcasting Area extends from the Atlantic to the meridian 40 E.
minaret	Slender tower with balconies.
nadir	The point below the observer that is directly opposite the zenith on the imaginary sphere against which celestial bodies appear to be projected. <i>Asking that question was the nadir of my career.</i>
<u>peak</u>	Referring to the point at which the specified thing is at its highest level of popularity. <i>Traffic speeds are reduced at peak hours.</i>
<u>pinnacle</u>	Surmount with a pinnacle. Catapulted Einstein to the pinnacle of fame.
<u>plateau</u>	A relatively flat highland. The peace process had reached a plateau .
proliferation	A rapid increase in number (especially a rapid increase in the number of deadly weapons. Stress levels are high forcing upon them a proliferation of ailments.
raised	Embellished with a raised pattern created by pressure or embroidery. <i>Raised</i> needlework.
rung	A horizontal support on a ladder for a person's foot. We must ensure that the low skilled do not get trapped on the bottom rung .
<u>summit</u>	Reach the summit of a mountain. They started climbing at 3 45 a m and summit ed at 8 45 p m.
superlative	The superlative form of an adjective or adverb. Most surely is the superlative of the adverb surely.
towering	Of great intensity. A majestic towering album.
turret	A low armoured tower, typically one that revolves, for a gun and gunners in a ship, aircraft, fort, or tank. <i>A castle with fairy tale turrets.</i>
<u>unsurpassed</u>	Better or greater than any other. The quality of workmanship is unsurpassed .
<u>upper</u>	Denoting a younger (and hence usually shallower) part of a stratigraphic division or archaeological deposit or the period in which it was formed or deposited. The upper stories.



uppermost	Highest in place, rank, or importance. The uppermost book in the pile.
<u>zenith</u>	The time at which something is most powerful or successful. In 1977 punk was at its zenith .
