<b>hardened</b>	Used of persons emotionally hardened. <i>A battle <b>hardened</b> veteran.</i>
<b>hardheaded</b>	Unreasonably rigid in the face of argument or entreaty or attack. <i>A <b>hardheaded</b> appraisal of our position.</i>
<b>hardy</b>	United States slapstick comedian who played the pompous and overbearing member of the Laurel and Hardy duo who made many films (1892-1957). <i><b>Hardy</b> explorers of northern Canada.</i>
<b>husky</b>	Deep and harsh sounding as if from shouting or illness or emotion- Virgil Thomson. <i>Clothing sizes for <b>husky</b> boys.</i>
<b>inflexible</b>	Resistant to being bent. <i>An <b>inflexible</b> knife blade.</i>
<b>inured</b>	Made tough by habitual exposure- Robert Lynd- V.S.Pritchett. <i>A peasant dark lean faced wind <b>inured</b>.</i>

<b>manliness</b>	The traditional male quality of being brave and strong. <i>Men accustomed to proving their <b>manliness</b> on the streets.</i>
<b>masculine</b>	A masculine word or form. <i>The <b>masculine</b> rhyme of annoy enjoy.</i>
<b>muscular</b>	Having a robust muscular body build characterized by predominance of structures bone and muscle and connective tissue developed from the embryonic mesodermal layer. <i>The <b>muscular</b> and passionate Fifth Symphony.</i>
<b>potent</b>	Having a strong physiological or chemical effect. <i><b>Potent</b> liquor.</i>
<b>raspy</b>	Unpleasantly harsh or grating in sound. <i>His voice was <b>raspy</b> from days of non stop campaigning.</i>
<b>resolute</b>	Characterized by quickness and firmness. <i>A <b>resolute</b> and unshakeable faith.</i>
<b>rigidity</b>	The quality of being rigid and rigorously severe. <i>There was a regrettable <b>rigidity</b> in this decision.</i>
<b>rigidness</b>	The physical property of being stiff and resisting bending.
<b>robust</b>	Marked by richness and fullness of flavor. <i>A <b>robust</b> tale.</i>
<b>rowdy</b>	A cruel and brutal fellow. <i><b>Rowdy</b> teenagers.</i>
<b>solid</b>	A substance or object that is solid rather than liquid or fluid. <i>The bank is <b>solid</b> and will survive this attack.</i>
<b>stalwart</b>	A loyal, reliable, and hard-working supporter of or participant in an organization or team. <i>The <b>stalwart</b> citizens at Lexington.</i>
<b>strong</b>	Relating to or denoting the strongest of the known kinds of force between particles which acts between nucleons and other hadrons when closer than about 10 cm so binding protons in a nucleus despite the repulsion due to their charge and which conserves strangeness parity and isospin. <i>A cup of <b>strong</b> coffee.</i>
<b>sturdy</b>	(of a person or their body) strongly and solidly built. <i>The bike is <b>sturdy</b> enough to cope with bumpy tracks.</i>
<b>uncompromising</b>	Harsh or relentless. <i>She was <b>uncompromising</b> In her convictions.</i>
<b>unyielding</b>	Stubbornly unyielding T S Eliot. <i>An <b>unyielding</b> head support.</i>

Having or characterized by strength and energy.
