<u>across</u>	Referring to a crossword answer which reads horizontally. <i>Halfway</i> <b>across</b> Jenny jumped.
along	In addition (usually followed by `with. <i>He continued to plod <b>along</b>.</i>
alphabetical	Relating to or expressed by a writing system that uses an alphabet. <i>Alphabetical</i> characters.
barograph	A recording barometer; automatically records on paper the variations in atmospheric pressure.
chase	A rectangular metal frame used in letterpress printing to hold together the pages or columns of composed type that are printed at one time. <i>The policeman</i> <b>chase</b> <i>d the mugger down the alley.</i>
dictation	Speech intended for reproduction in writing. <i>The <b>dictation</b> of letters.</i>
<u>directory</u>	A board in an organization or large store listing names and locations of departments, individuals, etc.
discography	A descriptive catalogue of musical recordings, particularly those of a particular performer or composer. Jazz fans direct their intellectual energy to <b>discography</b> .
disk	Computer science a memory device consisting of a flat disk covered with a magnetic coating on which information is stored. <i>The moon s disk hung in a cloudless sky.</i>
<u>document</u>	Support or accompany with documentation. The photographer spent years <b>document</b> ing the lives of miners.
<u>ensue</u>	Issue or terminate (in a specified way, state, etc.); end. <i>The difficulties which</i> <b>ensue</b> <i>d from their commitment to Cuba</i> .
evidential	Of or providing evidence. <i>Evidential</i> signs of a forced entry.



<u>file</u>	Smooth with a file. The students <b>file</b> d into the classroom.
lane	A narrow way or road. The shipping <b>lane</b> s of the South Atlantic.
listing	An entry on an official register of securities accepted for trading and quotation on a stock exchange.
phonograph	Machine in which rotating records cause a stylus to vibrate and the vibrations are amplified acoustically or electronically.
platform	A woman's shoe with a very high thick sole. Seeking election on a <b>platform</b> of low taxes.
railroad	Supply with railroad lines. They know I was <b>railroad</b> ed and falsely accused.
railway	A line of track providing a runway for wheels. A <b>railway</b> line.
registration	The series of letters and figures identifying a motor vehicle assigned on registration and displayed on a number plate. In certain cases children may acquire British citizenship through <b>registration</b> .
<u>station</u>	A bus or coach station. The lookout resumed his <b>station</b> in the bow.
stenographer	A person whose job is to transcribe speech in shorthand. A court <b>stenographer</b> .
succeed	Be the successor (of. We <b>succeed</b> ed in getting tickets to the show.
syllabus	An integrated course of academic studies. There isn t time to cover the <b>syllabus</b> .
<u>trail</u>	A trailer for a film or broadcast. A recent television <b>trail</b> for The Bill.
<u>transcribe</u>	Write out from speech, notes, etc. The anthropologist <b>transcribe</b> d the sentences of the native informant.
transcription	(genetics) the organic process whereby the DNA sequence in a gene is copied into mRNA; the process whereby a base sequence of messenger RNA is synthesized on a template of complementary DNA. <i>Our usual transcription</i> is given in brackets.
transliterate	Write or print (a letter or word) using the closest corresponding letters of a different alphabet or script. <i>The Sanskrit text had to be transliterated</i> .



<u>traverse</u>	An area of land surveyed with a traverse. The plaintiff must assert certain facts which if <b>traverse</b> d he would be put to prove.
<u>walkway</u>	A passage or path for walking along, especially a raised passageway connecting different sections of a building or a wide path in a park or garden.
