along	With a forward motion. <i>We drove along admiring the view.</i>
chase	Cut a furrow into a columns. <i>The company employs people to chase up debts.</i>
course	A series of changes which brings the bells back to their original order, or the changes of a particular bell. <i>Many of the hares coursed escaped unharmed.</i>
enclosure	The state of being enclosed, especially in a religious community. <i>A deer enclosure.</i>
ensue	Issue or terminate (in a specified way, state, etc.); end. <i>The difficulties which ensued from their commitment to Cuba.</i>
follow	Follow with the eyes or the mind. <i>If you ve been following me on Facebook recently you may have seen a bunch of different posts about surgery and back trouble.</i>
highway	A major road for any form of motor transport. <i>A six lane highway.</i>
lane	A dark streak or band which shows up against a bright background, especially in a spiral galaxy. <i>A bus lane.</i>
listing	A database containing an ordered array of items (names or topics).
pass	An act of passing the hands over something as in conjuring or hypnotism. <i>The pain eventually passed off.</i>
path	A course of action or way of achieving a specified result. <i>A chosen career path.</i>

platform	The declared policy of a political party or group. <i>The speaker mounted the platform.</i>
pursuit	A cycling race in which competitors set off from different parts of a track and attempt to overtake one another. <i>The cat crouched in the grass in pursuit of a bird.</i>
quest	The act of searching for something. <i>He was a real scientist questing after truth.</i>
racetrack	A course over which races are run.
railroad	Supply with railroad lines. <i>Railroad tracks.</i>
railway	A network of tracks with the trains, organization, and personnel required for its working. <i>Services were disrupted after an eight year old boy was spotted trespassing on the railway.</i>
retrace	Reassemble mentally. <i>We retraced the route we took last summer.</i>
road	A railroad. <i>Clara had to walk in the road to avoid black plastic rubbish sacks.</i>
route	Send via a specific route. <i>All lines of communication were routed through London.</i>
speeder	A driver who exceeds the safe speed limit.
stadium	An ancient Roman or Greek measure of length about 185 metres originally the length of a stadium.
station	Assign to a station. <i>A naval station.</i>
succeed	Attain fame, wealth, or social status. <i>We succeeded in getting tickets to the show.</i>
trace	Discover traces of. <i>Trace the student s progress.</i>
trail	A trailer for a film or broadcast. <i>The bride s veiled trailed along the ground.</i>
traverse	An area of land surveyed with a traverse. <i>He crept up and threw a grenade over the traverse.</i>
vestige	The smallest amount. <i>The last vestiges of colonialism.</i>
walkway	A passage or path for walking along, especially a raised passageway connecting different sections of a building or a wide path in a park or garden.
