adventure	Put at risk. <i>In any military adventure the first casualty is truth.</i>
adventurous	Involving new ideas or methods. <i>An adventurous traveller.</i>
archaeologist	An anthropologist who studies prehistoric people and their culture. <i>Chinese archaeologists uncovered life sized terracotta statues.</i>
astronomer	A physicist who studies astronomy.
atlas	A figure of a man used as a supporting column. <i>I looked in the atlas to see where Naples was.</i>
audacious	Disposed to venture or take risks. <i>A series of audacious takeovers.</i>
bold	A bold typeface or letter. <i>I slapped him when he was bold.</i>
cartographer	A person who draws or produces maps. <i>A cartographer in the British army.</i>

conquistador	An adventurer (especially one who led the Spanish conquest of Mexico and Peru in the 16th century).
daring	Disposed to venture or take risks. <i>A daring crime.</i>
<u>escapade</u>	A wild and exciting undertaking (not necessarily lawful). <i>He told of their escapade with a borrowed truck.</i>
exploration	The action of exploring an unfamiliar area. <i>He called for a careful exploration of the consequences.</i>
explorer	Someone who travels into little known regions (especially for some scientific purpose). <i>A polar explorer.</i>
frontiersman	A man who lives on the frontier.
geographer	An expert on geography.
<u>immigration</u>	The body of immigrants arriving during a specified interval. <i>A barrier to control illegal immigration from Mexico.</i>
journey	Undertake a journey or trip. <i>An eight hour train journey.</i>
map	Make a map of show or establish the features of details of. <i>The project to map the human genome.</i>
<u>mapping</u>	The process of locating genes on a chromosome.
<u>navigator</u>	The member of an aircrew who is responsible for the aircraft's course. <i>The driver relies on his navigator s skill at reading the road.</i>
nonnative	Of persons born in another area or country than that lived in. <i>Our large nonnative population.</i>
overseas	In a foreign country. <i>He spent quite a lot of time working overseas.</i>
prospector	Someone who explores an area for mineral deposits. <i>I see myself as a prospector of opportunities for my clients.</i>
<u>stranger</u>	Anyone who does not belong in the environment in which they are found. <i>She remained a stranger to him.</i>
<u>tour</u>	Take a performer production etc on tour. <i>He decided to tour France.</i>
tourist	Travel as a tourist. <i>American families touristing abroad.</i>
travel	The action of travelling. <i>He travelled for a wholesale wine firm and had samples of numerous South Tyrolean wines in his case.</i>

Willing to take risks or embark on difficult or unusual courses of action.

world
