Definitions of "Treatise" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “treatise” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A written work dealing formally and systematically with a subject.*
- *A formal exposition.*

Synonyms of "Treatise" as a noun (12 Words)

critique	A detailed analysis and assessment of something, especially a literary, philosophical, or political theory. <i>A critique of Marxist historicism.</i>
discourse	A formal discussion of a topic in speech or writing. <i>A discourse on critical theory.</i>
disquisition	An elaborate analytical or explanatory essay or discussion. <i>Nothing can kill a radio show quicker than a disquisition on intertextual analysis.</i>
dissertation	A treatise advancing a new point of view resulting from research; usually a requirement for an advanced academic degree. <i>A dissertation on the novels of the Bront sisters.</i>
essay	A tentative attempt. <i>A misjudged essay in job preservation.</i>

<u>exposition</u>	A systematic interpretation or explanation (usually written) of a specific topic. <i>A systematic exposition of the idea of biodiversity.</i>
monograph	A detailed written study of a single specialized subject or an aspect of it. <i>They are publishing a series of monographs on music in late medieval and Renaissance cities.</i>
paper	A newspaper. <i>A recently leaked cabinet paper.</i>
piece of writing	A musical work that has been created.
study	A room used for reading and writing and studying. <i>Ira's face was a study as he approached the car.</i>
<u>thesis</u>	(in Hegelian philosophy) a proposition forming the first stage in the process of dialectical reasoning. <i>His central thesis is that psychological life is not part of the material world.</i>
work	A place where work is done. <i>I decided to get a work.</i>
