- *A written work dealing formally and systematically with a subject.*
- *A formal exposition.*

### Synonyms of "Treatise" as a noun (12 Words)

<b>critique</b>	A detailed analysis and assessment of something, especially a literary, philosophical, or political theory. <i>A <b>critique</b> of Marxist historicism.</i>
<a href="#">discourse</a>	A formal discussion of a topic in speech or writing. <i>A <b>discourse</b> on critical theory.</i>
<b>disquisition</b>	An elaborate analytical or explanatory essay or discussion. <i>Nothing can kill a radio show quicker than a <b>disquisition</b> on intertextual analysis.</i>
<b>dissertation</b>	A treatise advancing a new point of view resulting from research; usually a requirement for an advanced academic degree. <i>A <b>dissertation</b> on the novels of the Bront sisters.</i>
<b>essay</b>	A tentative attempt. <i>A misjudged <b>essay</b> in job preservation.</i>

<b><u>exposition</u></b>	A systematic interpretation or explanation (usually written) of a specific topic. <i>A systematic <b>exposition</b> of the idea of biodiversity.</i>
<b>monograph</b>	A detailed written study of a single specialized subject or an aspect of it. <i>They are publishing a series of <b>monographs</b> on music in late medieval and Renaissance cities.</i>
<b>paper</b>	A newspaper. <i>A recently leaked cabinet <b>paper</b>.</i>
<b>piece of writing</b>	A musical work that has been created.
<b>study</b>	A room used for reading and writing and studying. <i>Ira s face was a <b>study</b> as he approached the car.</i>
<b><u>thesis</u></b>	(in Hegelian philosophy) a proposition forming the first stage in the process of dialectical reasoning. <i>His central <b>thesis</b> is that psychological life is not part of the material world.</i>
<b>work</b>	A place where work is done. <i>I decided to get a <b>work</b>.</i>
