# **Conjugate Trek**

## **Trek in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>trek</b>	We <b>trek</b>
You <b>trek</b>	You <b>trek</b>
He/She/It <b>treks</b>	They <b>trek</b>

## **Trek in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am trekking	We <b>are trekking</b>
You <b>are trekking</b>	You <b>are trekking</b>
He/She/It is trekking	They are trekking

#### **Trek in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have trekked	We have trekked
You have trekked	You have trekked
He/She/It has trekked	They have trekked

### **Trek in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been trekking	We have been trekking
You <b>have been trekking</b>	You have been trekking
He/She/It has been trekking	They have been trekking

# **Trek in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>trekked</b>	We <b>trekked</b>
You <b>trekked</b>	You <b>trekked</b>
He/She/It <b>trekked</b>	They <b>trekked</b>

## **Trek in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was trekking	We <b>were trekking</b>
You <b>were trekking</b>	You were trekking
He/She/It was trekking	They were trekking

#### **Trek in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had trekked	We had trekked
You <b>had trekked</b>	You had trekked
He/She/It had trekked	They had trekked

## **Trek in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been trekking	We had been trekking
You <b>had been trekking</b>	You had been trekking
He/She/It had been trekking	They had been trekking

# **Trek in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will trek	We <b>will trek</b>
You <b>will trek</b>	You <b>will trek</b>
He/She/It will trek	They will trek

# **Trek in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be trekking	We <b>will be trekking</b>
You <b>will be trekking</b>	You will be trekking
He/She/It will be trekking	They will be trekking

### **Trek in Future Perfect Tense**

#### **Trek in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been trekking	We <b>will have been trekking</b>
You <b>will have been trekking</b>	You <b>will have been trekking</b>
He/She/It will have been trekking	They will have been trekking
