<b>gargantuan</b>	Enormous. <i>A <b>gargantuan</b> appetite.</i>
<b>giant</b>	Used in names of very large animals and plants e g giant hogweed giant tortoise. <i>Walton built a retail <b>giant</b>.</i>
<b><u>gigantic</u></b>	So exceedingly large or extensive as to suggest a giant or mammoth. <i><b>Gigantic</b> disappointment.</i>
<b>huge</b>	Extremely large; enormous. <i><b>Huge</b> government spending.</i>
<b>immense</b>	Unusually great in size or amount or degree or especially extent or scope. <i><b>Immense</b> numbers of birds.</i>
<b>large</b>	A garment size for a large person. <i>A big or <b>large</b> barn.</i>
<b>largeness</b>	Large or extensive in breadth or importance or comprehensiveness. <i>A man distinguished by the <b>largeness</b> and scope of his views.</i>

<b>mammoth</b>	So exceedingly large or extensive as to suggest a giant or mammoth. A <b>mammoth</b> ship.
<b>massive</b>	Consisting of great mass; containing a great quantity of matter. <b>Massive</b> retaliatory power.
<b>monstrosity</b>	A grossly malformed animal or plant. They regarded the atom bomb as a <b>monstrosity</b> .
<b>monstrous</b>	Inhumanly or outrageously evil or wrong. He wasn't lovable he was <b>monstrous</b> and violent.
<b>odds</b>	The ratio between the amounts staked by the parties to a bet, based on the expected probability either way. He offered <b>odds</b> of two to one.
<b>ogre</b>	(folklore) a giant who likes to eat human beings. It is clear that I am no <b>ogre</b> .
<b>oversize</b>	Larger than normal for its kind.
<b>oversized</b>	Larger than normal for its kind. An <b>oversized</b> T shirt.
<b>prodigious</b>	So great in size or force or extent as to elicit awe. A <b>prodigious</b> storm.
<b>proportion</b>	Give pleasant proportions to. The room despite its ample <b>proportions</b> seemed too small for him.
<b>ratio</b>	The quantitative relation between two amounts showing the number of times one value contains or is contained within the other. The <b>ratio</b> of men's jobs to women's is 8 to 1.
<b>scads</b>	A large number or quantity. They raised <b>scads</b> of children.
<b>sized</b>	Having a specified size. A grapefruit <b>sized</b> lump.
<b>stupendous</b>	Extremely impressive. The most <b>stupendous</b> views.
<b>titanic</b>	Of exceptional strength, size, or power. A series of <b>titanic</b> explosions.
