Synonyms of "Trendsetter" as a noun (13 Words)

advance guard	A tentative suggestion designed to elicit the reactions of others.
avant-garde	Any creative group active in the innovation and application of new concepts and techniques in a given field (especially in the arts).
cutting edge	The act of penetrating or opening open with a sharp edge.
driving force	Hitting a golf ball off of a tee with a driver.
fore	The front part of something, especially a ship.
forefront	The part in the front or nearest the viewer. <i>He was in the forefront.</i>
front	The part of a garment covering a person s front. <i>The Spartans preserving an even and unbroken front.</i>
front line	The part of something that is nearest to the normal viewer.
front rank	The atmospheric phenomenon created at the boundary between two different air masses.

- lead** A position of being the initiator of something and an example that others will follow especially in the phrase take the lead.
*The pensions revolution is the **lead** in the Times.*
- leading position** Thin strip of metal used to separate lines of type in printing.
- spearhead** An individual or group chosen to lead an attack or movement.
*She became the **spearhead** of a health education programme.*
- van** A caravan.
*He had been watching the marshalling of the fish **vans**.*
