Present Tense	<b>trick-or-treat / trick-or-treats</b>
Past Tense	<b>trick-or-treated</b>
Present Participle	<b>trick-or-treating</b>
Past Participle	<b>trick-or-treated</b>

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **trick-or-treat**                      We **trick-or-treat**  
You **trick-or-treat**                You **trick-or-treat**  
He/She/It **trick-or-treats**      They **trick-or-treat**

**Trick-or-treat in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am trick-or-treating**            We **are trick-or-treating**  
You **are trick-or-treating**        You **are trick-or-treating**  
He/She/It **is trick-or-treating**    They **are trick-or-treating**

**Trick-or-treat in Present Perfect Tense**

I **have trick-or-treated**            We **have trick-or-treated**
