defraud Illegally obtain money from (someone) by deception.

She **defraud**ed the customers who trusted her.

delude Make (someone) believe something that is not true.

Too many theorists have **delude**d the public.

faithless Having the character of, or characteristic of, a traitor.

They were ungodly and **faithless**.

falsehood Lying

The right to sue for malicious **falsehood**.

fraud A person who makes deceitful pretenses.

Prosecutions for social security **fraud**s.



fraudulence A fraudulent or duplicitous representation.

hoodwink Influence by slyness.

Staff were **hoodwink**ed into thinking the cucumber was a sawn off shotgun.

humbug A hypocrite.

His comments are sheer **humbug**.

An instance of a wrong or misinterpreted perception of a sensory

illusion experience.

He had no **illusion**s about the trouble she was in.

infidelity The action or state of being unfaithful to a spouse or other sexual partner.

Her **infidelity** continued after her marriage.

legerdemain Skilful use of one's hands when performing conjuring tricks.

A classic piece of management **legerdemain**.

The way direction or position in which something lies.

She **lie**d when she told me she was only 29.

perfidious to the Carthaginians by the Romans.

The **perfidious** Judas.

perfidyThe state of being deceitful and untrustworthy.

Hapsburg **perfidy**.

purposely With intention; in an intentional manner.

She had **purposely** made it difficult.

scam A fraudulent business scheme.

A guy that **scam**s old pensioners out of their savings.

The act of swindling by some fraudulent scheme.

He is mixed up in a 10 million insurance **swindle**.

thaumaturgy Any art that invokes supernatural powers.

He attracts people by his **thaumaturgy**.

traitorous Relating to or characteristic of a traitor; treacherous.

A lying **traitorous** insurrectionist.

Tending to betray especially having a treacherous character as attributed to

treacherous the Carthaginians by the Romans.

A holidaymaker was swept away by **treacherous** currents.

treachery

Betrayal of a trust.

Many died because of his **treachery**.

untruth A lie or false statement (often used euphemistically.
