**cheat** An act of cheating a fraud or deception.

**cheater** Something immaterial that interferes with or delays action or progress.

confidence man A secret that is confided or entrusted to another.

**cut-up** Someone who plays practical jokes on others.

deceiver Someone who leads you to believe something that is not true.defrauder A person who swindles you by means of deception or fraud.

**fraudster** A person who commits fraud, especially in business dealings.
