Definitions of "Trifecta" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “trifecta” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A run of three wins or grand events.*
- *A bet in which the person betting forecasts the first three finishers in a race in the correct order.*



Synonyms of "Trifecta" as a noun (4 Words)

- ante** The initial contribution that each player makes to the pot.
*The **antes** were at the 10 000 20 000 level.*
- gamble** A risky act or venture.
*We decided to take a **gamble** and offer him a place on our staff.*
- stake** A pole or stake set up to mark something as the start or end of a race track.
*The corner of the lot was indicated by a **stake**.*
- wager** The money risked on a gamble.
*Rose placed a **wager** on a jockey she knew.*

Usage Examples of "Trifecta" as a noun

- *He will attempt a trifecta of the long jump, triple jump, and 110-meter high hurdles.*
