## Associations of "Trilogy" (30 Words)

<b>after</b>	At a later or future time afterwards. <i>The week <b>after</b> I was back at school.</i>
<b>continuance</b>	The time for which a situation or action lasts. <i>The king s ministers depended on his favour for their <b>continuance</b> in office.</i>
<a href="#"><b>continuation</b></a>	A part added to a book or play that continues and extends it. <i>The <b>continuation</b> of discussions about a permanent peace.</i>
<b>cord</b>	A length of cord. <i>He was dressed in faded black <b>cords</b>.</i>
<b>film</b>	Make a film or photograph of something. <i>The table was covered with a <b>film</b> of dust.</i>
<b>four</b>	A playing card or domino or die whose upward face shows four pips.
<b>leash</b>	Put a leash on a dog. <i>Kept a tight <b>leash</b> on his emotions.</i>
<b>movie</b>	A form of entertainment that enacts a story by sound and a sequence of images giving the illusion of continuous movement. <i>They went to a <b>movie</b> every Saturday night.</i>
<b>numeral</b>	A word expressing a number. <i>He learned to write the <b>numerals</b> before he went to school.</i>
<a href="#"><b>ongoing</b></a>	Continuing; still in progress. <i><b>Ongoing</b> negotiations.</i>
<b>quadruple</b>	A quadruple number or amount. <i><b>Quadruple</b> rhythm has four beats per measure.</i>
<a href="#"><b>reprise</b></a>	A repeated passage in music. <i>A stale <b>reprise</b> of past polemic.</i>
<b>rope</b>	Enclose or separate an area with a rope or tape. <i>We stopped at the foot of the ridge and <b>roped</b> up.</i>

<b>sequel</b>	Something that takes place after or as a result of an earlier event. <i>The <b>sequel</b> to Home Alone.</i>
<b><u>sequence</u></b>	Arrange in a sequence. <i>The poems should be read in <b>sequence</b>.</i>
<b>sequential</b>	Forming or following in a logical order or sequence. <i>A series of <b>sequential</b> steps.</i>
<b>series</b>	A set of books, periodicals, or other documents published in a common format or under a common title. <i>The first four books in the Toybox Science <b>series</b>.</i>
<b>six</b>	Denoting a quantity consisting of six items or units.
<b>subsequence</b>	The state of following something, especially as a result or effect. <i>An affair which appeared in due <b>subsequence</b> in the newspapers.</i>
<b>succession</b>	A group of strata representing a single chronological sequence. <i>A <b>succession</b> of stalls offering soft drinks.</i>
<b>ternary</b>	Composed of three parts. <i>A <b>ternary</b> operation.</i>
<b><u>tertiary</u></b>	A lay associate of certain Christian monastic organizations. <i>A Franciscan <b>tertiary</b>.</i>
<b><u>tether</u></b>	Tie with a tether. <i>Regulations banning neck and girth <b>tethers</b> for sows.</i>
<b><u>three</u></b>	One of four playing cards in a deck having three pips.
<b><u>triad</u></b>	A member of a Triad. <i>The <b>triad</b> of medication diet and exercise are necessary in diabetes care.</i>
<b>tricycle</b>	Ride on a tricycle. <i>A small boy <b>tricycled</b> to the end of his driveway.</i>
<b><u>trinity</u></b>	The state of being three. <i>God is said to be <b>trinity</b> in unity.</i>
<b>trio</b>	Three people considered as a unit. <i>A jazz <b>trio</b>.</i>
<b><u>triple</u></b>	Hit a triple. <i>Grain prices were expected to <b>triple</b>.</i>
<b>triptych</b>	A picture or relief carving on three panels, typically hinged together vertically and used as an altarpiece. <i>A <b>triptych</b> on the theme of the holocaust.</i>
