Associations of "Trilogy" (30 Words)

after	At a later or future time afterwards. <i>The week after I was back at school.</i>
continuance	The time for which a situation or action lasts. <i>The king s ministers depended on his favour for their continuance in office.</i>
<u>continuation</u>	A part added to a book or play that continues and extends it. <i>The continuation of discussions about a permanent peace.</i>
cord	A length of cord. <i>He was dressed in faded black CORDS.</i>
film	Make a film or photograph of something. <i>The table was covered with a film of dust.</i>
four	A playing card or domino or die whose upward face shows four pips.
leash	Put a leash on a dog. <i>Kept a tight leash on his emotions.</i>
movie	A form of entertainment that enacts a story by sound and a sequence of images giving the illusion of continuous movement. <i>They went to a movie every Saturday night.</i>
numeral	A word expressing a number. <i>He learned to write the numerals before he went to school.</i>
<u>ongoing</u>	Continuing; still in progress. <i>Ongoing negotiations.</i>
quadruple	A quadruple number or amount. <i>Quadruple rhythm has four beats per measure.</i>
<u>reprise</u>	A repeated passage in music. <i>A stale reprise of past polemic.</i>
rope	Enclose or separate an area with a rope or tape. <i>We stopped at the foot of the ridge and roped up.</i>

sequel	Something that takes place after or as a result of an earlier event. <i>The sequel to Home Alone.</i>
<u>sequence</u>	Arrange in a sequence. <i>The poems should be read in sequence.</i>
sequential	Forming or following in a logical order or sequence. <i>A series of sequential steps.</i>
series	A set of books, periodicals, or other documents published in a common format or under a common title. <i>The first four books in the Toybox Science series.</i>
six	Denoting a quantity consisting of six items or units.
subsequence	The state of following something, especially as a result or effect. <i>An affair which appeared in due subsequence in the newspapers.</i>
succession	A group of strata representing a single chronological sequence. <i>A succession of stalls offering soft drinks.</i>
ternary	Composed of three parts. <i>A ternary operation.</i>
<u>tertiary</u>	A lay associate of certain Christian monastic organizations. <i>A Franciscan tertiary.</i>
<u>tether</u>	Tie with a tether. <i>Regulations banning neck and girth tethers for sows.</i>
<u>three</u>	One of four playing cards in a deck having three pips.
<u>triad</u>	A member of a Triad. <i>The triad of medication diet and exercise are necessary in diabetes care.</i>
tricycle	Ride on a tricycle. <i>A small boy tricycled to the end of his driveway.</i>
<u>trinity</u>	The state of being three. <i>God is said to be trinity in unity.</i>
trio	Three people considered as a unit. <i>A jazz trio.</i>
<u>triple</u>	Hit a triple. <i>Grain prices were expected to triple.</i>
triptych	A picture or relief carving on three panels, typically hinged together vertically and used as an altarpiece. <i>A triptych on the theme of the holocaust.</i>
