- *The union of the Father and Son and Holy Ghost in one Godhead.*

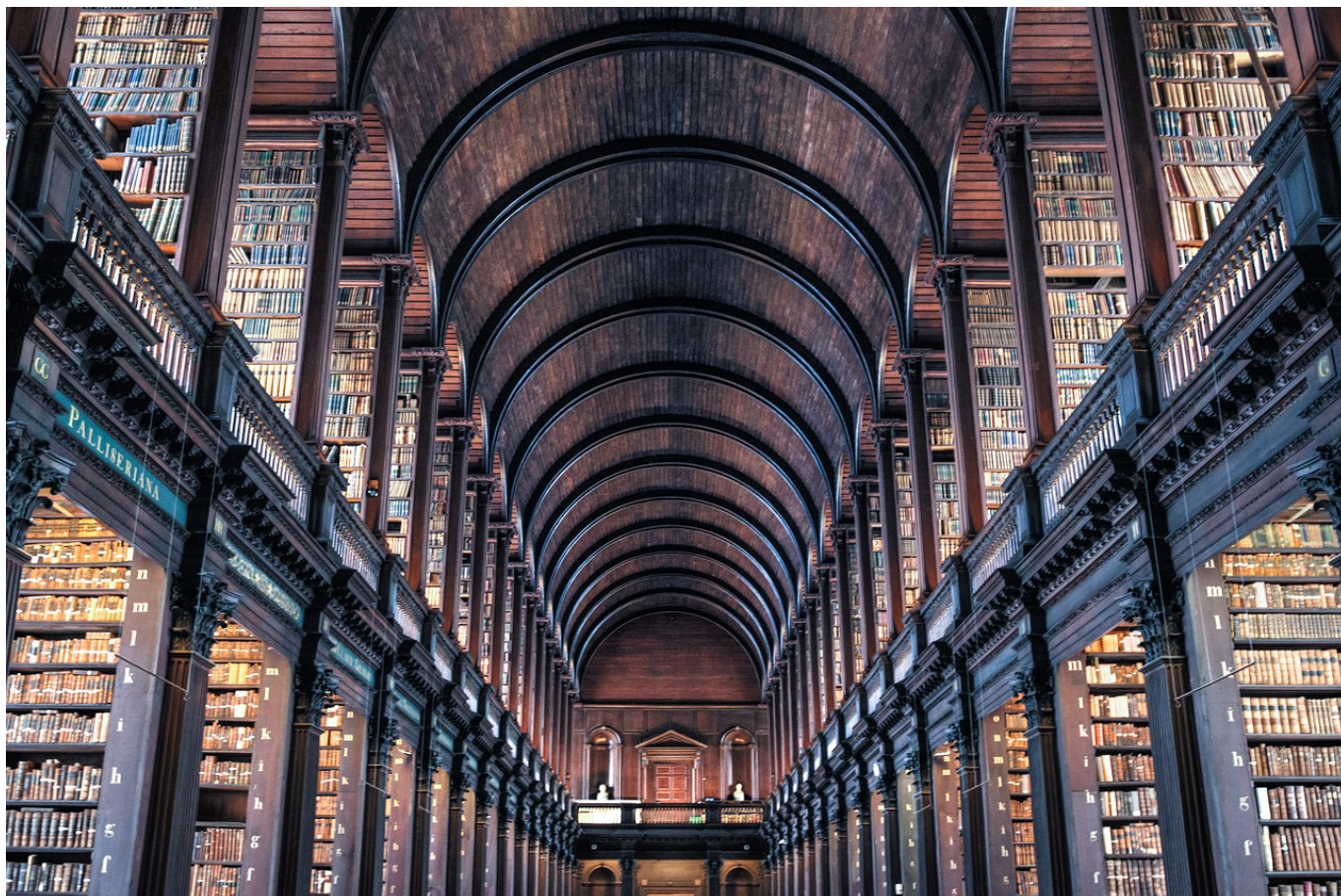


## Synonyms of "Trinity" as a noun (22 Words)

<b>iii</b>	The cardinal number that is the sum of one and one and one.
<b>leash</b>	Restraint consisting of a rope (or light chain) used to restrain an animal. <i>Kept a tight <b>leash</b> on his emotions.</i>
<b>tercet</b>	The cardinal number that is the sum of one and one and one.
<b>ternary</b>	The cardinal number that is the sum of one and one and one.
<b>ternion</b>	The cardinal number that is the sum of one and one and one.
<b>terzetto</b>	A vocal or instrumental trio.
<b><a href="#">three</a></b>	One of four playing cards in a deck having three pips.
<b>tierce</b>	An organ stop sounding two octaves and a major third above the pitch of the diapason.

<b>trey</b>	A playing card or dice with three spots.
<b>triad</b>	A three-note major or minor chord; a note and its third and fifth tones. <i>The <b>triad</b> of medication diet and exercise are necessary in diabetes care.</i>
<b>triangle</b>	A thing shaped like a triangle. <i>The coastline of Chile and Argentina and Brazil forms two legs of a <b>triangle</b>.</i>
<b>trine</b>	An aspect of 120° (one third of a circle). <i>A <b>trine</b> aspect.</i>
<b>trio</b>	A set or group of three people or things. <i>A jazz <b>trio</b>.</i>
<b>triplet</b>	An atomic or molecular state characterized by two unpaired electrons with parallel spins. <i>She was expecting <b>triplets</b>.</i>
<b>triplets</b>	A set of three similar things considered as a unit.
<b>triplex</b>	A triple-stranded polynucleotide molecule.
<b>triumvirate</b>	(in ancient Rome) a group of three men holding power, in particular (the First Triumvirate) the unofficial coalition of Julius Caesar, Pompey, and Crassus in 60 BC and (the Second Triumvirate) a coalition formed by Antony, Lepidus, and Octavian in 43 BC. <i>A <b>triumvirate</b> of three executive vice presidents.</i>
<b>troika</b>	A team of three horses for a troika.

- *The wine was the first of a trinity of three excellent vintages.*

<b>double</b>	<b>Double</b> chrysanthemums have many rows of petals and are usually spherical or hemispherical.
<b>five</b>	A playing card or a domino or a die whose upward face shows five pips.
<b>four</b>	A playing card or domino or die whose upward face shows four pips.
<b>fourth</b>	In the fourth place. <b>Fourthly</b> you must pay the rent on the first of the month.
<b>leash</b>	Put a leash on a dog. His violence was barely <b>leashed</b> .

<b>million</b>	A very large indefinite number (usually hyperbole. <i>There were <b>millions</b> of flies.</i>
<b>multiple</b>	(of a disease, injury, etc.) complex in its nature or effects; affecting several parts of the body. <i><b>Multiple</b> birth.</i>
<b>numeral</b>	A symbol used to represent a number. <i>A <b>numeral</b> adjective.</i>
<b>once</b>	At a previous time. <i>If she <b>once</b> got an idea in her head you d never move it.</i>
<b>one</b>	Being a single entity made by combining separate components. <i>Two animals of <b>one</b> species.</i>
<b>pirouette</b>	Perform a pirouette. <i>She <b>pirouetted</b> and made a bow.</i>
<b>quadruple</b>	A quadruple number or amount. <i>A <b>quadruple</b> murder.</i>
<b>quartet</b>	A composition for a quartet. <i>A <b>quartet</b> of comfortable armchairs.</i>
<b>sextet</b>	A composition for a sextet. <i>A <b>sextet</b> of new releases.</i>
<b>sextuple</b>	Having six units or components.
<b>six</b>	Denoting a quantity consisting of six items or units.
<b>sixth</b>	Coming next after the fifth and just before the seventh in position.
<b>ten</b>	One of four playing cards in a deck with ten pips on the face.
<b>ternary</b>	Composed of three parts. <i>A <b>ternary</b> operation.</i>
<b>tertiary</b>	From 63 million to 2 million years ago. <i>The <b>tertiary</b> stage of the disease.</i>
<b>tether</b>	Tie with a tether. <i>Check if Wi Fi access is free in the lobby or <b>tether</b> your phone.</i>
<b>third</b>	The fielding position of the player on a baseball team who is stationed near the third of the bases in the infield counting counterclockwise from home plate. <i>He was cut down on a close play at <b>third</b>.</i>
<b>three</b>	One of four playing cards in a deck having three pips.
<b>triad</b>	A group or set of three related people or things. <i>The <b>triad</b> of medication diet and exercise are necessary in diabetes care.</i>
<b>tricycle</b>	Ride on a tricycle. <i>A small boy <b>tricycled</b> to the end of his driveway.</i>
