Synonyms of "Troublemaker" as a noun (11 Words)

agitator	A person who urges others to protest or rebel. <i>A political agitator.</i>
bad hat	That which is below standard or expectations as of ethics or decency.

<u>firebrand</u>	A person who is very passionate about a particular cause. <i>A political firebrand.</i>
incendiary	An incendiary bomb or device. <i>He was an English incendiary responsible for the burning of three French battleships.</i>
inciter	Someone who deliberately foments trouble.
instigator	A person who initiates a course of action. <i>She was the instigator of their quarrel.</i>
mischief-maker	Someone who deliberately stirs up trouble.
rabble-rouser	A political leader who seeks support by appealing to popular passions and prejudices.
ringleader	A person who leads (especially in illicit activities). <i>The four ringleaders were sentenced to death on the gibbet.</i>
trouble maker	An effort that is inconvenient.
troubler	Someone who deliberately stirs up trouble.
