- agitator** A person who urges others to protest or rebel.  
*A political **agitator**.*
- bad hat** That which is below standard or expectations as of ethics or decency.



<b>firebrand</b>	A person who is very passionate about a particular cause. <i>A political <b>firebrand</b>.</i>
<b>incendiary</b>	An incendiary bomb or device. <i>He was an English <b>incendiary</b> responsible for the burning of three French battleships.</i>
<b>inciter</b>	Someone who deliberately foments trouble.
<b>instigator</b>	A person who initiates a course of action. <i>She was the <b>instigator</b> of their quarrel.</i>
<b>mischief-maker</b>	Someone who deliberately stirs up trouble.
<b>rabble-rouser</b>	A political leader who seeks support by appealing to popular passions and prejudices.
<b>ringleader</b>	A person who leads (especially in illicit activities). <i>The four <b>ringleaders</b> were sentenced to death on the gibbet.</i>
<b>trouble maker</b>	An effort that is inconvenient.
<b>troubler</b>	Someone who deliberately stirs up trouble.
