Synonyms of "Tryout" as a noun (4 Words)

- audition** An interview for a role or job as a singer, actor, dancer, or musician, consisting of a practical demonstration of the candidate’s suitability and skill.
*The Royal Ballet gave Nicola an **audition**.*
- test** The act of undergoing testing.
*The **test** was standardized on a large sample of students.*
- trial** The act of testing something.
*In the experimental **trials** the amount of carbon was measured separately.*
- trial run** The determination of a person’s innocence or guilt by due process of law.
