## Typecast as a Verb

### Definitions of "Typecast" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “typecast” as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Identify as belonging to a certain type.*
- *Represent or regard (a person or their role) as fitting a particular stereotype.*
- *Cast repeatedly in the same kind of role.*
- *Assign (an actor or actress) repeatedly to the same type of role, as a result of the appropriateness of their appearance or previous success in such roles.*

### Synonyms of "Typecast" as a verb (8 Words)

<b>categorize</b>	Place into or assign to a category. <i>Children learn early on to <b>categorize</b>.</i>
<b>compartmentalize</b>	Separate into isolated compartments or categories. <i>You cannot <b>compartmentalize</b> your life like this.</i>
<b>conventionalize</b>	Represent according to a conventional style. <i>Highly <b>conventionalized</b> ways of distinguishing between good and evil.</i>
<b>label</b>	Distinguish as a compound or molecule by introducing a labeled atom. <i>Many pupils felt that they were <b>labelled</b> as failures.</i>

<b>pigeonhole</b>	Put a document in a pigeonhole. <i>She <b>pigeonholed</b> her worry about him.</i>
<b>standardize</b>	Determine the properties of (something) by comparison with a standard. <i>We could <b>standardize</b> on US equipment.</i>
<b>tag</b>	Attach a monitoring tag to. <i>We have to <b>tag</b> the sheep before sale or when moving them from one farm to another.</i>
<b>type</b>	Write something on a typewriter or computer by pressing the keys. <i><b>Type</b> the acceptance letter please.</i>

### Usage Examples of "Typecast" as a verb

- *People are not as likely to be typecast by their accents as they once were.*
- *He tends to be typecast as the caring, intelligent male.*
