## Synonyms of "Ultra" as a noun (9 Words)

- diehard** A person who strongly opposes change or who continues to support something in spite of opposition.  
*A **diehard** Yankees fan.*
- [extremist](#) A person who holds extreme political or religious views, especially one who advocates illegal, violent, or other extreme action.  
***Extremist** groups.*
- fanatic** A person with an obsessive interest in and enthusiasm for a particular activity.  
*Religious **fanatics**.*
- [militant](#) A militant person.  
***Militants** became increasingly impatient of parliamentary manoeuvres.*
- [radical](#) A radical sign.  
*In the body free **radicals** are high energy particles that ricochet wildly and damage cells.*

**rebel** A person who takes part in an armed rebellion against the constituted authority especially in the hope of improving conditions.  
*Tory **rebels**.*

**revolutionary** A radical supporter of political or social revolution.

**subversive** A subversive person.  
*The government claimed we were **subversives** or terrorists.*

**zealot** A fervent and even militant proponent of something.



## Usage Examples of "Ultra" as a noun

- *The best way to tackle an ultra is to divide the race into manageable chunks.*
- *Ultras in the animal rights movement.*



## Ultra as an Adjective

### Definitions of "Ultra" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), "ultra" as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Far beyond the norm.*
- *(used of opinions and actions) far beyond the norm.*



## Synonyms of "Ultra" as an adjective (2 Words)

**extremist** (used of opinions and actions) far beyond the norm.  
*Extremist political views.*

**radical**

Markedly new or introducing radical change.

**Radical** leaves.
