### Synonyms of "Unabashed" as an adjective (20 Words)

<b>audacious</b>	Unrestrained by convention or propriety. <i><b>Audacious</b> explorers.</i>
<b>barefaced</b>	Unrestrained by convention or propriety. <i>His years of working <b>barefaced</b> breathing down dust.</i>
<b><u>blatant</u></b>	Without any attempt at concealment; completely obvious. <i><b>Blatant</b> disregard of the law.</i>
<b>bold</b>	Erotic, risqué, or sexually provocative. <i>A figure carved in <b>bold</b> relief.</i>
<b>bold as brass</b>	Fearless and daring.

<b>brazen</b>	Made of or resembling brass (as in color or hardness). <i><b>Brazen</b> arrogance.</i>
<b>confident</b>	Not liable to error in judgment or action. <i>A <b>confident</b> reply.</i>
<b>fearless</b>	Invulnerable to fear or intimidation. <i><b>Fearless</b> reporters and photographers.</i>
<b>flagrant</b>	(of an action considered wrong or immoral) conspicuously or obviously offensive. <i><b>Flagrant</b> violation of human rights.</i>
<b>immodest</b>	Having or showing an exaggerated opinion of your importance, ability, etc. <i>TV shows full of <b>immodest</b> language.</i>
<b>shameless</b>	(of a person or their conduct) characterized by or showing a lack of shame; barefaced or brazen. <i>A <b>shameless</b> imposter.</i>
<b>unashamed</b>	Expressed or acting openly and without guilt or embarrassment. <i>An <b>unashamed</b> emotionalism.</i>
<b>unblushing</b>	Not feeling or showing embarrassment or shame. <i>An <b>unblushing</b> apologist for fascism.</i>
<b>unconcerned</b>	Lacking in interest or care or feeling. <i>Blithely <b>unconcerned</b> about his friend's plight.</i>
<b>undaunted</b>	Not intimidated or discouraged by difficulty, danger, or disappointment. <i>They were <b>undaunted</b> by the huge amount of work needed.</i>
<b>undismayed</b>	Not dismayed or discouraged by a setback. <i>Wholly <b>undismayed</b> by the commercial failure of the three movies he had made.</i>
<b>unembarrassed</b>	Not embarrassed- Jerome Stone. <i>An <b>unembarrassed</b> silence.</i>
<b>unflinching</b>	Not showing fear or hesitation in the face of danger or difficulty. <i>He has shown <b>unflinching</b> determination throughout the campaign.</i>
<b>unrepentant</b>	Stubbornly persistent in wrongdoing. <i>He was <b>unrepentant</b> and said that his comments were completely accurate.</i>
<b>unshrinking</b>	Not shrinking from danger.

- *He was unabashed by the furore his words provoked.*
