An **unblushing** apologist for fascism.

Lacking in interest or care or feeling.

unconcerned Blithely **unconcerned** about his friend s plight.

Not intimidated or discouraged by difficulty, danger, or disappointment. undaunted

They were **undaunted** by the huge amount of work needed.

Not dismayed or discouraged by a setback.

undismayed Wholly **undismayed** by the commercial failure of the three movies he

had made.

unembarrassed Not embarrassed-Jerome Stone.

An **unembarrassed** silence.

Not showing fear or hesitation in the face of danger or difficulty. unflinching

He has shown **unflinching** determination throughout the campaign.

Stubbornly persistent in wrongdoing.

He was **unrepentant** and said that his comments were completely unrepentant

accurate.

unshrinking Not shrinking from danger.
