**disputed** Subject to disagreement and debate.

**doubtful** Feeling uncertain about something.

It is **doubtful** whether these schemes have any lasting effect.

**in doubt** Holding office.

Of a victor having won an open competition.

open Open ballots.

**open to debate** Full of small openings or gaps.

**open to question** Not brought to a conclusion; subject to further thought.

**pending** Awaiting decision or settlement.

Business still **pending**.



**undecided** Characterized by indecision.

Too many voters still declare they are **undecided**.

Not precisely determined or established; not fixed or known in advance.

**undetermined** The bus was travelling with an **undetermined** number of passengers

when it crashed.

unreciprocated Not returned in kind.

His feelings for her were unreciprocated.

unrequited Not returned in kind.

He s been pining with **unrequited** love.

unresolved Characterized by musical dissonance harmonically unresolved.

A number of issues remain **unresolved**.

**unsettled** Subject to change. An **unsettled** issue.

**up in the air** Operating properly.
