Synonyms of "Unapologetic" as an adjective (12 Words)

absolute	Complete and without restriction or qualification; sometimes used informally as intensifiers. <i>The policy is absolute folly.</i>
complete	Perfect and complete in every respect having all necessary qualities. <i>The harvesting was complete.</i>
confirmed	Of persons; not subject to change. <i>A confirmed bachelor.</i>
deep-rooted	Deeply rooted; firmly fixed or held.

<u>entrenched</u>	(of an attitude, habit, or belief) firmly established and difficult or unlikely to change; ingrained. <i>The entrenched power of the nobility.</i>
established	Brought about or set up or accepted especially long established. <i>Thick established plants can be pruned by cutting out about one third of all stems.</i>
inveterate	Habitual. <i>His inveterate hostility to what he considered to be the reactionary powers.</i>
out-and-out	No longer fashionable.
<u>thorough</u>	Performed or written with great care and completeness. <i>A thorough nuisance.</i>
thoroughgoing	Involving or attending to every detail or aspect of something. <i>Thoroughgoing research.</i>
through and through	Having finished or arrived at completion.
<u>utter</u>	Without qualification; used informally as (often pejorative) intensifiers. <i>Charlotte stared at her in utter amazement.</i>
