- (usually used with `to') occurring or existing without the knowledge of.

Synonyms of "Unbeknownst" as an adjective (1 Word)

unbeknown Occurring or existing without the knowledge of. She had been ill for months **unbeknown**st to the family.

Usage Examples of "Unbeknownst" as an adjective

• She had been ill for months, unbeknownst to the family.

According to the Oxford Dictionary of English, "unbeknownst" as an adverb can have the following definitions:

• Without someone's knowledge.

Synonyms of "Unbeknownst" as an adverb (1 Word)

 $\begin{tabular}{ll} \textbf{unbeknown} & \textbf{Without someone's knowledge}. \\ \textbf{Unbeknown} & \textbf{to me she made all the arrangements}. \\ \end{tabular}$

Usage Examples of "Unbeknownst" as an adverb

• Unbeknownst to me, she made all the arrangements.
