Synonyms of "Unbothered" as an adjective (10 Words)

relaxed	Without strain or anxiety. <i>Make sure that your jaw is relaxed.</i>
serene	Not agitated; without losing self-possession. <i>He remained serene in the midst of turbulence.</i>
tranquil	Free from disturbance; calm. <i>A lake of tranquil blue water reflecting a tranquil blue sky.</i>
unagitated	Not physically disturbed or set in motion.
undisturbed	Not disturbed. <i>He could pursue his studies undisturbed.</i>
unflustered	Not agitated; calm and self-controlled. <i>She seemed surprisingly unflustered by the delay.</i>
unmoved	Emotionally unmoved. <i>Her opponents were unmoved and plan to return to court.</i>

unperturbed Free from emotional agitation or nervous tension.
*Kenneth seems **unperturbed** by the news.*

unruffled Free from emotional agitation or nervous tension.
*Robbie seemed **unruffled** by her words.*

untroubled Not feeling, showing, or affected by anxiety or problems.
***Untroubled** times.*

Usage Examples of "Unbothered" as an adjective

- *She was unbothered by the mess in the sink.*
