serene Not agitated; without losing self-possession.

He remained **serene** in the midst of turbulence.

Free from disturbance; calm.

unagitated Not physically disturbed or set in motion.

Not disturbed.

undisturbed
He could pursue his studies undisturbed.

unflustered Not agitated; calm and self-controlled.

She seemed surprisingly **unflustered** by the delay.

unmoved Emotionally unmoved.

Her opponents were **unmoved** and plan to return to court.



Free from emotional agitation or nervous tension. Kenneth seems **unperturbed** by the news. unperturbed

Free from emotional agitation or nervous tension. unruffled

Robbie seemed unruffled by her words.

Not feeling, showing, or affected by anxiety or problems. untroubled

Untroubled times.
