unlimited	Having no limits in range or scope. <i>Offshore reserves of gas and oil are not</i> unlimited .

<u>ceaseless</u>	Uninterrupted in time and indefinitely long continuing. The fort was subjected to ceaseless bombardment.
<u>continually</u>	Without interruption; constantly. I was continually moving around.
continuously	With unflagging resolve. These images loop continuously .
endless	Tiresomely long; seemingly without end. <i>The list is endless.</i>
<u>eternal</u>	Continuing forever or indefinitely. <i>Eternal</i> truths of art and life.
<u>forever</u>	For a limitless time- P.P.Bliss. It took forever to get a passport.
illimitable	Without limits or an end. The illimitable human capacity for evil.
immeasurable	Beyond calculation or measure. Immeasurable suffering.
<u>immortal</u>	An immortal being especially a god of ancient Greece or Rome. <i>He will always be one of the immortals of soccer.</i>
incessant	Uninterrupted in time and indefinitely long continuing. <i>The incessant beat of the music.</i>
indefinitely	To an unlimited or unspecified degree or extent. An indefinitely large number of channels.
inestimable	Beyond calculation or measure. A treasure of inestimable value.
inexhaustible	That cannot be entirely consumed or used up. <i>His inexhaustible energy.</i>
<u>infinite</u>	A space or quantity that is infinite. <i>Intimations of the infinite.</i>
<u>infinity</u>	The state or quality of being infinite. <i>The lawns stretched into infinity.</i>
interminable	Tiresomely long; seemingly without end. We got bogged down in interminable discussions.



<u>limitless</u>	Without limits in extent or size or quantity. A limitless supply of money.
measureless	Without limits in extent or size or quantity. <i>Otto had measureless charm.</i>
mortician	An undertaker.
permanently	In a way that lasts or remains unchanged indefinitely; for all time. <i>He is permanently disabled</i> .
perpetual	Never ending or changing. He grows perpetual flowering carnations.
renewable	(of a natural resource or source of energy) not depleted when used. Renewable energy such as solar energy is theoretically inexhaustible.
<u>unchecked</u>	Not examined or checked. Prices rose unchecked hitting the poor worst of all.
<u>undying</u>	Never dying. His undying fame.
unfettered	Not bound by shackles and chains. Unfettered artistic genius.
<u>uninhibited</u>	Not inhibited or restrained. Fits of uninhibited laughter.
unlimited	Having no limits in range or scope. <i>Offshore reserves of gas and oil are not</i> unlimited .
<u>unrestrained</u>	Marked by uncontrolled excitement or emotion. <i>Unrestrained</i> laughter.
unrestricted	Not restricted or exclusive. I had unrestricted access.
