| long-lasting | Existing for a long time. |
| <u>resistant</u> | Disposed to or engaged in defiance of established authority. Cooked rice like bread contains a useful amount of resistant starch which acts like fibre in the digestive system. |

shatterproof Resistant to shattering or splintering.
*All windows are made of **shatterproof** glass.*
