- Take the burden off; remove the burden from.

Synonyms of "Unburden" as a verb (5 Words)

confess Confess to God in the presence of a priest as in the Catholic faith.

*St Ambrose would weep bitter tears when confess*ing a sinner.

Relieve (someone's mind) of worries.

I decided to **disburden** myself of the task.

open one's heart Display the contents of a file or start an application as on a computer.

tell all Give evidence.
tell one's all Give evidence.

- Unburden the donkey.
- The need to unburden yourself to someone who will listen.
