### Synonyms of "Unchanging" as an adjective (14 Words)

<b><a href="#">consistent</a></b>	Marked by an orderly logical and aesthetically consistent relation of parts. <i>Testimony <b>consistent</b> with the known facts.</i>
<b>constant</b>	Steadfast in purpose or devotion or affection. <i>Maintained a <b>constant</b> temperature.</i>
<b><a href="#">eternal</a></b>	Tiresomely long; seemingly without end. <i><b>Eternal</b> truths of art and life.</i>
<b>even</b>	Being level or straight or regular and without variation as e g in shape or texture or being in the same plane or at the same height as something else i e even with. <i>Any number doubled is <b>even</b>.</i>

<b>fixed</b>	Having a fixed and unchanging value. <i>The <b>fixed</b> assumptions of the Cold War.</i>
<b><u>permanent</u></b>	Lasting or intended to last or remain unchanged indefinitely. <i>He s in a <b>permanent</b> state of rage.</i>
<b>perpetual</b>	(of an investment) having no fixed maturity date; irredeemable. <i>Deep caves in <b>perpetual</b> darkness.</i>
<b><u>predictable</u></b>	Always behaving or occurring in the way expected. <i>The market is volatile and never <b>predictable</b>.</i>
<b>regular</b>	Relating to a person who does something regularly. <i>A <b>regular</b> job.</i>
<b><u>stable</u></b>	(of an object or structure) not likely to give way or overturn; firmly fixed. <i>The economy is <b>stable</b>.</i>
<b><u>static</u></b>	Relating to statics. <i>A <b>static</b> population.</i>
<b><u>steady</u></b>	(of a ship) moving without deviation from its course. <i>A <b>steady</b> decline in the national birth rate.</i>
<b><u>uniform</u></b>	Denoting a garment forming part of a person s uniform. <i>A <b>uniform</b> package of amenities at a choice of hotels.</i>
<b>unvarying</b>	Unvarying in nature. <i>Principles of <b>unvarying</b> validity.</i>

## Associations of "Unchanging" (30 Words)

<b><u>ceaseless</u></b>	Constant and unending. <i>The <b>ceaseless</b> thunder of surf.</i>
<b>changeless</b>	Remaining the same for indefinitely long times. <i><b>Changeless</b> truths.</i>
<b><u>coherent</u></b>	Capable of thinking and expressing yourself in a clear and consistent manner. <i>They failed to develop a <b>coherent</b> economic strategy.</i>
<b><u>consistent</u></b>	Sometimes followed by with in agreement or consistent or reliable. <i>A <b>consistent</b> explanation.</i>

<b>constant</b>	A number representing a quantity assumed to have a fixed value in a specified mathematical context. <i>A <b>constant</b> lover.</i>
<b><u>continual</u></b>	Continual meaning seemingly uninterrupted is often used interchangeably with continuous meaning without interruption. <i><b>Continual</b> is often used interchangeably with continuous.</i>
<b><u>continually</u></b>	Repeated frequently in the same way; regularly. <i>I was <b>continually</b> moving around.</i>
<b>continuous</b>	Continuing in time or space without interruption- James Jeans. <i>A <b>continuous</b> rearrangement of electrons in the solar atoms results in the emission of light.</i>
<b>endless</b>	(of a belt, chain, or tape) having the ends joined to form a loop allowing continuous action. <i><b>Endless</b> debates.</i>
<b>equable</b>	Not varying or fluctuating greatly. <i>He could look sterner than his <b>equable</b> temperament would suggest.</i>
<b><u>ever</u></b>	At all times all the time and on every occasion. <i>They lived happily <b>ever</b> after.</i>
<b>everlasting</b>	Any of various plants of various genera of the family Compositae having flowers that can be dried without loss of form or color. <i>An <b>everlasting</b> reminder of this evening.</i>
<b>immutable</b>	Unchanging over time or unable to be changed. <i>The view of that time was that all species were <b>immutable</b> created by God.</i>
<b>incessant</b>	Uninterrupted in time and indefinitely long continuing. <i>Night and day we live with the <b>incessant</b> noise of the city.</i>
<b>incessantly</b>	Without interruption; constantly. <i>She talked about him <b>incessantly</b>.</i>
<b>indestructible</b>	Very long lasting. <i><b>Indestructible</b> plastic containers.</i>
<b>invariable</b>	A quantity that does not vary. <i>His <b>invariable</b> courtesy.</i>
<b>invariant</b>	Never changing. <i>The pattern of cell divisions was found to be <b>invariant</b>.</i>
<b><u>lasting</u></b>	Lasting a long time without change. <i>A long <b>lasting</b> friendship.</i>
<b><u>nonstop</u></b>	A flight made without intermediate stops between source and destination. <i>How many <b>nonstops</b> are there to Dallas.</i>

<b><u>permanent</u></b>	A series of waves in the hair made by applying heat and chemicals. <i>A <b>permanent</b> ban on the dumping of radioactive waste at sea.</i>
<b>perpetual</b>	Uninterrupted in time and indefinitely long continuing. <i>He grows <b>perpetual</b> flowering carnations.</i>
<b><u>perpetuity</u></b>	A bond or other security with no fixed maturity date. <i>He did not believe in the <b>perpetuity</b> of military rule.</i>
<b>persistent</b>	(of chemicals or radioactivity) remaining within the environment for a long time after introduction. <i>PCBs are <b>persistent</b> environmental contaminants.</i>
<b><u>steady</u></b>	Support or hold steady and make steadfast with or as if with a brace. <i><b>Steady</b> yourself.</i>
<b>sustained</b>	Continuing for an extended period or without interruption. <i>Several years of <b>sustained</b> economic growth.</i>
<b>unceasing</b>	Not coming to an end; continuous. <i>The <b>unceasing</b> efforts of the staff.</i>
<b><u>unchangeable</u></b>	Not liable to variation or able to be altered. <i>The <b>unchangeable</b> seasons.</i>
<b>uninterrupted</b>	Without a break in continuity. <i>A convalescent needs <b>uninterrupted</b> sleep.</i>
<b><u>unremitting</u></b>	Never relaxing or slackening; incessant. <i><b>Unremitting</b> demands of hunger.</i>
