### Synonyms of "Uncharacteristic" as an adjective (17 Words)

<b><a href="#">aberrant</a></b>	Markedly different from an accepted norm. <i><b>Aberrant</b> chromosomes.</i>
<b>abnormal</b>	Much greater than the normal. <i>An <b>abnormal</b> interest in food.</i>
<b>alternative</b>	Pertaining to unconventional choices. <i>An <b>alternative</b> lifestyle.</i>
<b>anomalous</b>	Deviating from the general or common order or type. <i>Advanced forms of life may be <b>anomalous</b> in the universe.</i>
<b><a href="#">atypical</a></b>	Deviating from normal expectations; somewhat odd, strange, or abnormal. <i><b>Atypical</b> pneumonia.</i>

<b>curious</b>	Having curiosity aroused; eagerly interested in learning more. <i><b>Curious</b> investigators.</i>
<b>different</b>	Differing from all others; not ordinary. <i>On two <b>different</b> occasions.</i>
<b>exotic</b>	Being or from or characteristic of another place or part of the world. <i>There was a touch of the <b>exotic</b> in her appearance.</i>
<b>novel</b>	Original and of a kind not seen before. <i>The computer produced a completely <b>novel</b> proof of a well known theorem.</i>
<b>odd</b>	Beyond or deviating from the usual or expected. <i>She looked younger than her fifty <b>odd</b> years.</i>
<b>out of the ordinary</b>	Excluded from use or mention.
<b>peculiar</b>	Belonging exclusively to. <i>Rights <b>peculiar</b> to the rich.</i>
<b>uncommon</b>	Marked by an uncommon quality especially superlative or extreme of its kind. <i>An <b>uncommon</b> name.</i>
<b>unconventional</b>	Not conforming to legality, moral law, or social convention. <i><b>Unconventional</b> life styles.</i>
<b>unorthodox</b>	Breaking with convention or tradition. <i>He frequently upset other scholars with his <b>unorthodox</b> views.</i>
<b>unusual</b>	Not commonly encountered. <i>A man of <b>unusual</b> talent.</i>
<b>unwonted</b>	Unaccustomed or unusual. <i>There was an <b>unwonted</b> gaiety in her manner.</i>
